GEORGE ALLEN

Is being inducted into the Defense Industrial Supply Center Hall of Fame this twentieth day of January 1999 for his extraordinary leadership and support as the Deputy Commander and for his continuous outstanding mission support throughout his tenure at DISC from 1982 to 1995.

Mr. Allen was the Center's first Competition Advocate. In a span of six months of this program, competition rate was increased by 15 percent and provided a savings of almost \$30 million in its first year. Under his direction, a concept for automating the processing of recommended buys through the use of computer terminals was developed. This concept, ultimately called the Automated Inventory Management System (AIMS), was designed to reduce and prioritize Supply Operations workload, reduce creation of duplicate procurement requests, decrease administrative lead time and improve supply effectiveness.
