### **GERALD MIGNANO**

**Is posthumously inducted into the Defense Industrial Supply Center Hall of Fame this twelfth day of December 1997 for his extraordinary leadership and support as Supervisory Cost/Price Analyst in the Directorate of Contracting and Production and for his continuous outstanding mission support throughout his tenure at DISC from 1971 to 1989. Mr. Mignano formed the DISC Cost and Pricing Office. This was done to establish an accounting office devoted to the review of all high dollar contractor proposals. Due to his accounting and cost estimating efforts, contracting officers were able to save millions of dollars during contract negotiations. He was also an integral part of the formation of the Competition Advocate Office, and introduced sound accounting and cost principles to buyers and contracting officers working at the Center.**
