## Hall of Fame Inductees

## **JAMES WINSTON BRUMSKIN**

Is inducted into the Defense Personnel Support Center Hall of Fame this eleventh day of July 1996 for his extraordinary leadership and support as Chief of the Perishable Branch in the Supply Operations Division of DPSC's Subsistence Directorate – and for his continuous outstanding mission support throughout his tenure at DPSC –from 1953 to 1983. Mr. Brumskin was a true pioneer in supplying perishable food to the military services. He led the development of the global perishable food network into the world-class operation customers enjoy today. His innovations included the first use of commercial warehouses, and developing and improving DPSC's worldwide Defense Subsistence Offices. The DSOs represented an early and critical effort for both the Defense Logistics Agency and DPSC to incorporate commercial business practices decades before the era of privatization.
