MAJOR GENERAL JOHN J. CUSICK U.S. ARMY

Is inducted into the Defense Personnel Support Center Hall of Fame this sixteenth day of June 1995 for his extraordinary leadership and support as DPSC's 22nd Commander from 1990 to 1991. General Cusick's spontaneous leadership provided DPSC with the essential early preparation needed to support the massive commodity requirements of Operation Desert Shield and the Gulf War. These preparations at the hint of conflict allowed DPSC to meet all of its mission requirements, and provide outstanding service to the 540,000 Servicemen and women who served before, during and after the war.
