MILTON CUTTLER

Is inducted into the Defense Personnel Support Center Hall of Fame this third day of June 1997 for his extraordinary leadership and support as Assistant Chief, Technical Services Branch, Directorate of Medical Materiel – and for his continuous outstanding mission support throughout his tenure at DPSC – from 1953 to 1994. Mr. Cuttler was essential in establishing standards for pharmaceuticals and medical products when government standards were clearly inadequate. He assisted in developing and applying pharmaceutical manufacturing standards. As a program manager and leader in the Department of Defense Acquisition and Distribution of Commercial Products program, Mr. Cuttler led the effort to convert military specifications to commercial item descriptions. Mr. Cuttler was known for his support to all customers within the agency, as well as external customers.
