



Hall of Fame Inductees

NICHOLAS J. RANALLI

Is being inducted into the Defense Supply Center Philadelphia Hall of Fame this twenty-third day of October 2001 for his continuous outstanding mission support from 1976 through 1999. Mr. Ranalli was a superb leader, innovator, and visionary who maintained extraordinary relationships with the DISC workforce. He was responsible for the successful negotiation of the alternate work schedule, and developed courses for managers and union representatives which significantly improved management and labor relations. As the first civilian Administrator of DISC, he was instrumental in the successful merge of DISC and DSCP. Under his guidance and leadership, about 1,300 DISC employees were successfully placed in the new organization. Mr. Ranalli's achievements in reengineering business processes have significantly impacted the way DSCP and the Defense Logistics Agency conduct business today, and positions DSCP for a leadership role into the 21st century.
