is inducted into the Defense Supply Center Philadelphia Hall of Fame this twelfth day of October 2005 for his continuous outstanding mission support from 1965 through 2003. Mr. Fileccia's initiatives in DSCP Medical began the transformation from Military specifications to commercial product descriptions. He was a key member in the DoD/VA/Public Health Service Shared Procurement Program that combined purchases, reduced government resources and resulted in substantially lower prices. Under his direction, the National Mail Order Pharmacy Team was awarded the prestigious Defense Logistics Agency Scissors Award for "great work in cutting red tape." His entire career was molded by world events that required providing Medical support to customers during national disasters and various conflicts from the pre-Vietnam build-up to Operation Enduring Freedom. His vast knowledge of vaccines and antidotes represented a singular, corporate memory that kept the Directorate of Medical Materiel in the logistics vanguard. His legacy will live on forever in the Medical Directorate and the Pharmaceutical Industry.
