

Hall of Fame Inductees

THOMAS M. GARY

Is inducted into the Defense Personnel Support Center Hall of Fame this third day of June 1997 for his extraordinary leadership and support as the Chief Supervisory Management Analyst in the Office of Planning & Management - and for his continuous outstanding mission support throughout his tenure at DPSC - from 1954 to 1975. Mr. Gary's progressive approach put DPSC on the cutting edge of technology and business systems. He helped design and implement the Automated Payroll Cost and Personnel System (APCAPS), and he developed the specifications for the cost accounting segment. He served as the Project Officer for developing and implementing the Perishable Subsistence Automated Supply System (PSASS) in the U.S., and significantly aided in incorporating the system worldwide. Mr. Gary also developed simplified specifications for the Supply Automated Material Management System (SAMMS).
