The following clauses have been updated. All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.

FAR 52.216-19 - ORDER LIMITATIONS (OCT 1995)

(a) Minimum order. When the Government requires supplies or services covered by this contract in an amount of less than a \$50 minimum order, the Government is not obligated to purchase, nor is the Contractor obligated to furnish, those supplies or services under the contract.

(b) Maximum order. The maximum order limitation is the contract maximum dollar value \$30,000,000.00. The Contractor shall honor and deliver all orders for all contract customers (that exceed the minimum order requirement).

(c) If this is a requirements contract (i.e., includes the Requirements clause at subsection 52.216-21 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR)), the Government is not required to order a part of any one requirement from the Contractor if that requirement exceeds the maximum-order limitations in paragraph (b) of this section.

FAR 52.217-9 OPTION TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT (MAR 2000)

(a) The Government may extend the term of this contract by written notice to the Contractor within 3 days provided that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least 60 days before the contract expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the Government to an extension.

(b) If the Government exercises this option, the extended contract shall be considered to include this option clause.

(c) The total duration of this contract, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed 5 years. (NOTE: The performance period is defined as a twenty-two (22) base period, one (1) twelve (12) month option period, and one (1) twenty-four (24) month option period. There will be a fifty-five (55) day implementation period upon award.)
