Once the CRP has been approved by the Contracting Officer, the CRP becomes a part of this contract, and the Contractor must retain its records in accordance with the terms of the CRP. Should the Contractor's record retention procedures or the CRP change during the course of the 12 months preceding the next CRP submission date, the Contractor must submit the revised plan to the Contracting Officer for review and approval immediately.
