Singapore (Zone 2) – Voluntary Distribution Price Reduction (VDPR)

- A. Upon execution of MOD P00016, Coastal Pacific Food Distributors (CPFD) will reduce Category 66 distribution fees from the current rate of _____ per case to _____ per case.
- B. A new sub-category (66a) is established as a break out category from Category 66 for the CONUS procured items (i.e. Dr. Pepper and Gatorade products) and the new distribution price will be reduced from _____ per case to _____ per case.
- C. These VDPRs will be valid and effective for a time period of one (1) year from date of MOD execution.
- D. Prior to the conclusion of the one (1) year valid and effective period, CPFD will provide 90 days' notice to DLA of their decision to:
- 1) keep reduced distribution prices as indicated in A and B above in effect; or
 - 2) increase distribution prices above those prices indicated in A and B, but ultimately maintain a lower distribution price than the original price of _____ per case per Category, or
 - 3) increase distribution prices to the originally contracted rates of _____ per case for both Category 66 and 66a.
- Regardless of the course of action selected, that action will be in effect for an additional time period not to exceed one (1) year from the date of the modification mutually agreed upon by both CPFD and DLA.
- E. At no time will CPFD be permitted to increase distribution prices above the originally contracted prices.
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Philippines (Zone 4) - Voluntary Distribution Price Reduction (VDPR)

- A. Upon execution of MOD P00016, Coastal Pacific Food Distributors (CPFD) will reduce Category 66 distribution fees from the current rate of _____ per case to _____ per case.
- B. For newly established category 75 (locally procured water and soda), CPFD will reduce the distribution price from \$ _____ per case to \$ _____ per case.
- C. These VDPRs will be valid and effective for a time period of one (1) year from date of MOD execution.
- D. Prior to the conclusion of the one (1) year valid and effective period, CPFD will provide 90 days' notice to DLA of their decision to:
- 1) keep reduced distribution prices as indicated in A and B above in effect; or
 - 2) increase distribution prices above those prices indicated in A and B, but ultimately maintain a lower distribution price than the original prices of _____ and _____ per case for A and B respectively; or
 - 3) increase distribution prices to the originally contracted rates of _____ per case for category 66 and _____ per case for category 75.

Regardless of the course of action selected, that action will be in effect for an additional time period not to exceed one (1) year from the date of the modification mutually agreed upon by both CPFD and DLA.

- E. At no time will CPFD be permitted to increase distribution prices above the originally contracted prices.

NOTE: IF CASE SIZE WERE TO CHANGE FROM THE TRADITIONAL 24 QUANTITY / 12 OZ SIZE TO A SMALLER QUANTITY SIZE, THE GOVERNMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO INITIATE FURTHER NEGOTIATION OF DISTRIBUTION PRICES. CPFD AGREES TO PARTICIPATE IN THESE NEGOTIATIONS, SHOULD THEY OCCUR, IN GOOD FAITH.
