

Subject: ALFOODACT 020-2013 BBU, Inc. Issues A Voluntary Regional Recall Of Certain Limited Hamburger And Hot Dog Rolls Produced Under The Ballpark, Colonial, Great Value, Kerns, Kroger, Sara Lee And Sunbeam Brands And For Foodservice

Date Issued: May 10, 2013

2. BACKGROUND:

Bimbo Bakeries USA, Inc., the parent of the Bimbo Bakeries companies, has initiated a voluntary regional recall of Hamburger and Hog Dog Rolls due to possible presence of fragments of metal caused by a faulty manufacturing part at one North Carolina bakery. Recalled products are the fresh rolls with "Best By" dates (month and day) and UPC codes distributed in the states listed below. The recalled packages also contain the bakery code next to the printed Best By date.

The company announced the recall after discovering the faulty part in the bakery. No consumer reports have been received. There are no reports of injury.

No other products are affected.

Consumers who have purchased the product can return the product to its place of purchase for a full refund. Consumers with questions may contact the company at 1-800-984-0989 at any time 24 hours a day.

7. INSTRUCTIONS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR MESSAGE RECIPIENTS:

a. Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items and secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use.

POSITIVE FINDINGS should be reported to Accountable Officers/Vendor Representatives of that facility. Accountable Officer/Agency representatives/Buyers/Contracting Officers should seek/refund/credit/replacement through the normal distribution channel with which the product was received (i.e. Distribution Centers, Prime Vendors, or Manufacturers).

b. Ships at sea are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. In order to get credit please use a SF 364 and forward to your supporting NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center (NAVSUP FLC) and copy furnished to NAVSUP 51. Your supporting NAVSUP FLC should forward to the account manager at DLA Troop Support. The form should include the number of the recall authorizing the survey action. Home-ported ships/galleys will utilize DD form 1149 to transfer w/ reimbursement to the PV. The PV will submit credit invoice to the account manager at DLA Troop Support.

c. DLA Troop Support Subsistence Prime Vendors must report POSITIVE and NEGATIVE RESPONSES directly to the their DLA Troop Support Contracting Officer with a courtesy copy to the Consumer Safety Officer (dscpconssafofc@dla.mil)..

d. DeCA, AAFES, MWR, VA, MCCS, or other non-DLA Troop Support agencies SHOULD NOT respond to the DLA Troop Support Consumer Safety Officer. These agencies should report POSITIVE and NEGATIVE responses in accordance with their agency recall policies.
