Re: Waiver Request for Nutrition Labeling and Education Act (NLEA) labeling requirement for military unique components Shortbread bar, Chocolate chip dessert bar and Corn flakes cereal bar; MIL-S-44463, Shortbread bar, Food Packet, Survival, General Purpose; Sterling

On January 28, 2012 New View Oklahoma submitted a request to waive the requirement for a nutritional data label on the food bars produced by Sterling. Natick concurs with the waiver request for the omission of the NLEA label on the Food Packet, Survival, General Purpose ration bars.

The following is the rationale for granting the waiver request:

Natick received a letter from FDA in October 1994 that states military operational ration components are exempt from mandatory nutrition labeling except when nutrition claims are made for the product. However, in late 1990's, Natick began voluntarily including requirements for the NLEA within the component specifications to be more in line with the commercial food industry.

The corn flakes cereal bar, shortbread bar, and chocolate chip dessert bar documents have not been updated since the 1990's. Therefore, as a result no requirement for the NLEA has been incorporated into these Military Specifications. Sterling is not required to place NLEA label on the survival ration bars.

This modification is to have no impact on the item price; all other terms and conditions of the contract remain in effect.
