WEAPON SYSTEM ORACLE ROLES HIERARCHY

1. Once an end user has accessed a menu option (see appendix C-148), additional restrictions are placed on users by the data base. The data base security assigns Oracle data base roles as shown in the hierarchy to the user ID. A user can be assigned one or more roles. Each role is a collection of rules that govern the end user's access to data and applications in the data base. Any default set of roles corresponds to existing application security levels. DLSC-CSS creates or modifies roles to tighten or loosen security roles.
