WEAPON SYSTEM ADVICE CODES (WSACs)/WEAPON SYSTEM STATUS CODES (WSSCs)

PART I

WEAPON SYSTEM ADVICE CODES (WSACs)

1. Number of characters: Two.
2. Type of code: Alpha.
3. Explanation: WSACs are used in pos. 65-66 of the Weapon Item Data Transaction, DIC WS1, appendix B-144. The WSACs are used by the document initiator (usually the Military Services) to indicate the specific action to be taken for weapon system application request documents upon input to the Weapon System Data Base (WSDB) of the Weapon System Support Program (WSSP) processes. These codes are used in conjunction with appendix A-31 (WSATCs) codes on the F-140A and F-140B Reports.
4. Source: The WSAC AA, AC, and AD are initiated by the Military Services and are submitted via the Weapon Item Data Transaction, DIC WS1, to the WSSP. The WS1 AO is only internally generated at the DSCs from the Provisioning Subsystem which causes certain different, required processing and is not, therefore, to be used on external submissions by the military services or the DSCs.
5. The WSACs are listed and defined as follows:

<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
AA	<u>Add</u> - For the NSN, pos. 8-20, add weapon system application for the Weapon System Designator Code (WSDC), pos. 28-30, for the RIC (From) location, pos. 67-69, of this WS1 transaction.
AC	<u>Change</u> - The Weapon System Essentiality Code (WSEC), pos. 24, and/or Weapon System Maintenance Code (WSMC), pos. 25-26, are to be changed/overlayed for the NSN record identified in the WS1 transaction in the WSDB. Blanks are valid for these fields, pos. 24-26.
AD	<u>Delete</u> - The matching NSN, pos. 8-20, record having an identical RIC From, pos. 67-69, is to be deleted from its weapon system application record in the WSDB.

<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
AO	Add - (for internal <u>Provisioning</u> generation/use ONLY) - The NSN, pos. 8-20, is internally generated on WS1s from the Provisioning Subsystem processes only to add WS1 transaction records to the WSDB. Additionally, weapon system application records internally generated from Provisioning will contain a specially assigned Transaction Origination Code (TOC), appendix A-22, pos. 62, to identify those records which undergo certain required processing for the Provisioning initiated transactions prior to recordation on the WSDB.

Part II

WEAPON SYSTEM STATUS CODES (WSSCs)

1. Number of characters: Two.
2. Type of code: Alpha.
3. Explanation: WSSCs are used in pos. 65-66 of the Weapon Item Data Status Transaction, DIC WS3, appendix B-148, to provide the Services the status of the submitted Weapon System application upon input to the WSSP processes.
4. Source: The WSSCs are system generated to the Military Services and are defined in appendix A-57.

5. The WSSCs are listed and defined as follows:

<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
CA	Reject. This item is accounted for and managed by a DSC other than this DSC. Therefore, this weapon system application cannot be processed at this DSC. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CB	Reject. The NSN, pos. 8-20, is no longer a valid item of supply. Requests are being satisfied from either components, the Next Higher Assembly (NHA), or fabrication. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CD	Change. The NSN has been superseded by another NSN and has been replaced by the NSN in pos. 31-43. The WS1 with the replacing item will be treated as an initial submission and will get its own resultant processing and/or responses. If submitters records are not adjusted to show the replacing NSN, files will be compatible with DLAs WSSP. Adjust records accordingly.
CF	Reject. The WSDC, pos. 28-30, in the WS1 is invalid because it is not an authorized Weapon System Designator/Service Code (WSD/SVC) combination. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CG	Change. The NSN, pos. 8-20, in the WS1 transaction is coded nonstandard and has been consolidated with or transferred to the NSN in pos. 31-43. The WS1 with the overlaid item will be treated as an initial submission and will, therefore, get its own processing and responses. If service records are not adjusted/updated/changed IAW the CG WSSC change, files will be incompatible with the DSCs WSDB records. Adjust records accordingly.
CH	Reject. The WSAC, pos. 65-66, in the WS1 transaction is invalid, other than AA, AC, or AD from the submitting activity. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CL	Reject. The FSC (Federal Supply Class), pos. 8-11, in this WS1 transaction is either 5510, 5520, 5530, and is not authorized for the WSSP. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CM	Reject. The RIC (From), pos. 67-69, in the transaction is invalid or is not an authorized submitting activity for the WSDC, pos. 28-30. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.

CODE	DEFINITION
CN	Change. The WSMC, pos. 25-26, in the WS1 transaction is invalid. The WSMC field has been overlaid with blanks and the original WS1 document continues processing. Adjust records accordingly.
CO	Reject. The NSN, pos. 8-20, in the WS1 transaction is invalid. The NSN has been deleted without replacement. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CP	Reject. The NSN, pos. 8-20, is AAC W. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CQ	Reject. The NSN, pos. 8-20, in the WS1 transaction is coded terminal and not authorized for future purchase. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CR	Reject. The NSN, pos. 8-20, in the WS1 transaction has been canceled and deleted without replacement. An SSR is required to register the submitter as a user and reactivate the NSN. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CS	Change. The requested NSN, pos. 8-20, has become a member of another family (requirement family) as a result of the family change process. The requirements family head NSN, appears in pos. 31-43 of this WS3 document. The WS1 with the overlaid item, will be treated as an initial submission and will get its own processing and responses. If submitters records are not adjusted IAW the CS WSSC change, files will be incompatible with DLAs WSSP records.
CT	Reject. The NSN, pos. 8-20, cannot be identified. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CU	Change. The WSEC, pos. 24, in the WS1 transaction field is other than 1, 3, 5, 6, 7, or blank as authorized IAW SAMMS, appendix A-38, part 1. The WSEC field has been overlaid in the original WS1 document and has processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CV	Reject. The NSN, pos. 8-20, in the WS1 transaction is deleted and superseded when there is no recorded superseding NSN. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.

CODE	DEFINITION
CW	Reject. The NSN, pos. 8-20, in the WS1 transaction is deleted, consolidated, or transferred when there is no recorded NSN. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CX	Reject. The NSN, pos. 8-20, in the WS1 transaction is (deleted - either log loss with NSN and possible unit of issue (UI) change) or (deleted - log loss without NSN change) where there is no NSN recorded in the NIR. This WS1 has not been processed. Adjust records accordingly.
CZ	Change. The NSN, pos. 8-20, in this WS1 transaction is now being managed by another DSC as a result of either Consumable Item Transfer (CIT) or Base Realignment And Closures 95 (BRAC 95) and is, a Log Loss with NSN and possible UI or - without NSN change) catalog change action with the new GIM (Gaining Inventory Manager) available in our records. The GIM RIC has been overlaid to pos. 3-6, RIC To, of the original WS1 submission. The WS1 with the overlaid RIC To will be treated as an initial submission at the appropriate managing DSC and will get its own processing and responses. If service records are not adjusted IAW the CZ WSSC action, the service records will be incompatible with the DLAs WSSP records.
