VIOLATION REENTRY CODES (VRCs)

1. Violation Reentry Codes, as applicable, are entered into pos. 13-14, ZLR Reentry document, as a means of denoting to the mechanical system the desired type processing of the applicable transaction contained in the Violation Control File.

2. The following codes are assigned:

<u>REENTRY_CODE</u>	<u>EXPLANATION</u>
AR	Release violation from the Control File, overlaying only the corrected data element from the violation reentry into the control record.
BM	Release violation from the Control File and generate a DIC A3_, Passing Order to the RIC in pos. 67-69 and appropriate status to customer.
BQ, BR, BS	Delete violation from Control File and cancel transaction. Generate a DIC AE_, with Status Code BQ, BR or BS (see appendix A-12).
ER	Release violation from the Control File without any change in data elements.
D	Delete violation from Control File, no further processing required.
C_ (Applicable C_ Series or D2, D3 and D4 MILSTRIP Status Code)	Delete violation from Control File and reject transaction to customer. Generate SupplyStatus Card, DIC AE_, with applicable MILSTRIP Status Code cited and Effective Date Of Supply (EDOS) as applicable. (See appendix A-12.)
ZK	Release violation from the Control File. Update ARCSF and generate Supply Status Card, DIC AE_, with MILSTRIP Status Code BM. Do not generate passing order to DSC/ICP in pos. 67-69 providing off-line lateral support.
