INTERCHANGEABILITY AND SUBSTITUTABILITY (I&S) STATUS CODES

1. Number of Characters: One.
2. Type of Code: Alphabetic.
3. Explanation: These codes are mechanically assigned and maintained within the I&S File. These codes will identify status on specific NSN(s) within an I&S family or to a Service/Agency's entire Order of Use (OOU) that require a manual review (with the exception of Status Code D) and revision to the family IAW appendix E-413 P. These codes will appear in the I&S Section when interrogating the NIR either by inquiry via DIC ZCQ for an F-109 NIR Inquiry Printout or the SAMMSTEL CRT using the SNIR verb. NSNs containing these codes will be bypassed in the search for available assets in requisition processing.
4. Source: Status codes will be generated from (a) Catalog Change transactions, DIC ZRY, (b) I&S OOU transaction DIC ZIS and/or (c) Conditional Substitute Change transaction DIC ZJR processed from the Item Standardization Application (ISA) within the Technical and Logistics Subsystem of SAMMS.
5. The following codes are assigned:

<u>CODE</u>	<u>EXPLANATION</u>
C	Deleted item in NIRF. NSN has an NIR Key Code of D__.
D	Deleted record on I&S File. Service has deleted its previously established OOU data. Note: Whenever the DLA OOU is deleted the entire I&S File is deleted.
I	Delinked NSN in NIRF. NSN previously established into an I&S family as a result of an approved standardization relationship has been reversed out of the standardization determination.
S	Suspended Member NSN in Service Package. Whenever the DLA OOU is revised to delete NSN(s) and the revised Service OOU has not been processed the affected NSNs within the recorded Service OOU will be identified with this code.
