ACQUISITION ADVICE CODES (AACs)

1. Number of characters: One.
2. Type of code: Alpha.
3. Explanation: These codes reflect, in the Federal Cataloging System, how (as distinguished from where), and under what restrictions, an item will be acquired. Agency refers to Civil Agencies with the exclusion of the GSA and National Security Agency. The AAC reflects applications of three basic acquisition methods; i.e., by requisition, by fabrication or assembly, or by local purchase. The AAC, a data element in the DIDS TIR Segment H (Catalog Management Data), is used for customer level, not system level, acquisitions. AACs are related to the SSCs of appendix A-50. This relationship is displayed in appendix C-143. The data element AAC is also recorded in the DSCs NIR. The AAC is used in preparing the Supply Availability and Workload Analysis Report (appendix F-67) and Supply Operations Report (appendix F-40) only and is not involved in any other SAMMS process.

Requisitions will be submitted in accordance with Integrated Materiel Manager/Service requisitioning procedures.
E	Other Service Managed, Stocked, and Issued (Service Use only if SICA LOA is 8D and NIMSC is 6)	Issue, Transfer, or Shipment is not subject to specialized controls other than those imposed by the Services requisitioning policy. a. The item is centrally managed, stocked, and issued. b. Requisitions may require a fund citation and will be submitted in accordance with the Services requisitioning procedures.
F	Fabricate or Assemble	National Stock Numbered Items fabricated or assembled from raw materials and finished products as the normal method of support. Procurement and stockage of the items not justified because of low usage or peculiar installation factors. Distinctions between local or centralized fabricate/assemble capability are identified by the Source of Supply Modifier in the Source of Supply column of the Service Management Data Lists.
G	General Services Administration (GSA) or Veterans Administration (VA) Integrated Materiel Managed, Stocked, and Issued	Identifies GSA/VA-managed items available from GSA/VA Supply Distribution Facilities. Requisitions and citations will be submitted in accordance with SA/Service/VA requisitioning procedures.
H	Direct Delivery Under a Central Contract	Issue, Transfer, or Shipment is not subject to specialized controls other than those imposed by Integrated Materiel Manager/Service/Agency supply policy. a. The item is centrally managed and procured.

I	Direct Ordering From a Central Contract	Issue, Transfer, or Shipment is not subject to specialized controls other than those imposed by Integrated Materiel Manager/Service supply policy. The item is covered by a centrally issued contractual document, or by a multiple award Federal Supply Schedule for GSA managed items, which permits using activities to place orders directly on vendors for direct delivery to the user.
J	Not Stocked, Centrally Procured	IMM/Service centrally managed but not stocked item. Procurement will be initiated only after receipt of requisition.
K	Centrally Stocked for Overseas Only	Main means of supply is local purchase or direct ordering from a central contract/schedule when the Federal Supply Schedule Number is shown in the CMD Record. Item is stocked in domestic supply system for those overseas activities unable to procure locally due to nonavailability of procurement sources or where local purchase is prohibited (e.g., ASPR, Flow of Gold; or by internal Service/Agency restraints). Requisition will be submitted by overseas activities in accordance with Agency/Service requisitioning procedures.
		NOTE: CONUS activities will obtain supply support through local procurement procedures.
L	Local Purchase	DLA/GSA/Service/Agency-managed items authorized for local purchase, as a normal means of support, at base, post, camp, or station level. Item not stocked in wholesale distribution system of Integrated Materiel Manager/Service/Agency Inventory Control Point.

M	Restricted Requisitions-Major Overhaul (Service/Agency Use only)	Items (Assemblies and/or component parts) which for lack of specialized tools or test equipment, can be used only for major overhaul activities. Base, post, camp, or station activities will not requisition unless authorized to perform major overhaul functions.
N	Restricted Requisitioning-Disposal (Service/Agency Use only)	Discontinued items no longer authorized for issue except on the specific approval of the Inventory Manager. Requisitions may be submitted in accordance with Agency/Service requisitioning procedures in instances where valid requirements exist and replacing item data has not been furnished.
O	Packaged Fuels	DLA Managed and Service Regulated. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Item will be centrally procured in accordance with DoD 4140.25M but not stocked by IMM. Long leadtime required. b. Requirements will be satisfied by direct shipment to the user either from a vendor or from Service assets at the order of the ICP or IMM. c. Requirements and/or requisitions will be submitted IAW Service/Agency procedures.
P	Restricted Requisition-Security Assistance Program (SAP)	Indicates item is stocked or acquired only for SAP (replaces MAP) requirements. Base, post, camp, or stations will not requisition. Indicates item is nonstocked and materiel is ordered from the contractor for shipment directly to the foreign government.
Q	Bulk Petroleum Products	DLA Managed. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Item may be either centrally stocked or available by direct delivery under a central contract. b. Requirements will be submitted by military service in accordance with IMM procedures. c. Item will be supplied in accordance with DoD 4140.25M.
R	Restricted Requisition-Government Furnished Materiel (GFM)	Indicates item is centrally procured as GFM in connection with the manufacture of military items. Base, post, camp, or stations will not requisition.

Item is procured by a Service for the funding Service and is centrally managed by the funding Service. b. The procuring Service has no requirement in its logistic system for the item.
T	Condemned	Item no longer authorized for procurement, issue, use, or requisitioning.
U	Lead Service Managed	As a minimum provides procurement, disposal and single submitter functions.
V	Terminal Item	Identifies items in stock; but future procurement is not authorized. Requisitions may continue to be submitted until stocks are exhausted. Preferred NSN normally provided by the application of the phrase, When Exhausted Use (NSN). Requisition will be submitted in accordance with IMM/Service requisitioning procedures as applicable.
W	Restricted Requisitioning-Special Instructions Apply	Indicates stock number has been assigned to a generic item for use in bid invitations and allowance lists against which no stocks are ever recorded. Requisitions will be submitted only in accordance with IMM/Service requisitioning procedures. (This code will be used, when applicable, in conjunction with Phrase Code S (Stock as NSN(s)). It is considered applicable for use when a procurement source(s) becomes available. The Phrase Code S and the applicable stock as NSN(s) will then be applied for use in stock, store, and issue actions).
X	Semiactive Item-No Replacement	A potentially inactive NSN which must be retained in the supply system as item of supply because stocks of the item are on hand or in use below the wholesale level and the NSN is cited in equipment authorization documents, TO&E, TA, TM or in use assets are being reported. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Items are authorized for central procurement but not authorized for stockage at wholesale level. b. Requisitions for in use replacement will be authorized with individual Service Directives.

		c. Requisitions may be submitted as requirements generate. Repetitive demands may dictate an AAC change to permit wholesale stockage.

Requisitions will not be processed to the wholesale manager.</p> <p>b. Internal Service/Agency requisitioning may be continued in accordance with Service/Agency requisitioning policies.</p>
Z	Insurance/Numeric Stockage Objective Item	<p>Items that are generally not subject to periodic replacement or wear-out but subject to infrequent replacement as the result of accidents and other unexpected occurrences.</p> <p>a. The items are centrally managed by the Services/DSCs.</p> <p>b. Requisitions will be submitted in accordance with IMM/Service requisitioning procedures.</p>
