WEAPON SYSTEM ACTION TAKEN CODES (WSATCs)

1. Number of characters: Two.
2. Type of Code: Alpha.
3. Explanation: The WSATCs are a reflection of the action that was taken during processing for each Weapon System Advice Code (WSAC), appendix A-57, part 1, request for each DIC WS1, appendix B-144, transaction. This code is reflected on the appendix F-140A, all WS1 Submissions to the system report. For instance, if the WSAC AC processed as an AA because the record to be changed did not exist, then the WSAC would be AC and the WSATC would be AA.
4. Source: The WSATCs (AA, AC, AD, AN, ND) are generated by the WSSP and reflected on the appendix F-140A Report.
5. The WSATCs are listed and defined as follows:

<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
AA	The actual action taken during processing of the WS1 input was a record add.
AC	The actual action taken during processing of the WS1 input was a change (an overlay) of the WSEC/WSMC.
AD	The actual action taken during processing of the WS1 input was a record delete.
AN	The actual action taken during processing of the WS1 input was a first time add of an NSN to the data base.
ND	The actual action taken during processing of the WS1 input with WSAC AD was no action because there was no record to be deleted.
