PROJECT CATEGORY CODES

1. Number of characters: One or two.
2. Type of code: Alpha.
3. Explanation: These codes are assigned to each project to indicate the purpose and action required on requisitions and other documents containing valid Project Codes. If only one code is applicable, only one will be referenced.
4. Source: These codes are established in the Project Code Reference Table with a Project Code Reference Table, DIC ZHB.
5. The following codes are assigned:

<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
A	Reserved for intraservice action only. The code will be perpetuated in all related documentation and will appear as a part of shipping container markings. No meaning of the code will be disseminated outside the originating Service/Agency.
B	Mark Code Name/identifier on shipping container. For intra and interservice action. The code will be perpetuated in all related documentation and will appear as a part of shipping container markings. Special instructions pertaining to control requirements or references to appropriate directives containing such instructions will be included in the message announcing the establishment of the code.
C	Controlled Shipment/Special Instructions. For interservice/ Agency use only. Project code assigned by the DoD MILSTRIP System Administration for common purpose use by all or specified Service/Agencies. The code will be perpetuated in all related documentation and will appear as part of shipping container markings.

EXAMPLE: Project Category Code BC indicates a controlled shipment/ special instructions requiring special marking on shipment containers.
