SOURCE OF SUPPLY MODIFIER CODES

1. Number of characters: Three.
2. Type of code: Alpha or Alpha/Numeric.
3. Explanation: Source of Supply information is included in Catalog Management Data Files (CMDf) and is entered or changed through use of the Catalog Management Data Change Card. The Source of Supply Code is RIC of the activity to which requirements/requisitions are directed. The MILSTRIP RICs will be used where appropriate; however, where there is no established RIC, the following codes will be used.
