CUSTOMER/STORAGE LOCATION ZONE CODES (C/SLZCs)

1. Number of characters: one.
2. Type of Code: Numeric.
3. Explanation:

a. Customer Zone Codes (CZCs) indicate whether the customer is located in the Continental United States (CONUS) East, CONUS West, Overseas, Atlantic or Overseas, Pacific areas. The dividing line for CONUS East or West designation is the Mississippi River. The CZC is mechanically assigned concurrent with the mechanical assignment of the Geographic Area Codes (GACs) to the management section of the DoD Activity Address Directory (DoDAAD). The CZC is maintained by input of a DIC ZG\_ as described in appendix B-136. The CZC may be deleted by a DIC TA4, DoDAAD delete transaction only.

b. The CZC assigned to the individual DoDAAD is used to record the location of the demand in the Demand/Return History Listing, appendix F-191. The CZC is also used in the Materiel Returns Programs to determine due-in suspense dates of 120 days for CONUS and 180 days for Overseas customers.

c. The Storage Location Zone Codes indicate whether the storage location is located in the CONUS East, CONUS West, Overseas, Atlantic or Overseas, Pacific areas. The Storage Location Zone Code is entered in the Source Preference Table (SPT) by DIC ZHA as described in appendix B-123.

4. Source: DoDAAD or SPT as applicable.
5. The following codes are assigned:
