TYPE OF FILE CODES (TFCs)

1. Number of characters: One.
2. Type of code: Alpha.
3. Explanation: Indicates the source of a DoDAAD entry in the SAMMS Combined Address File.
4. The following codes are assigned:

<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
D	A permanent, interim or local DoDAAD entry which has been identified for deletion. The entry will be physically deleted when the DoDAAD Monitor inputs a TA4 with type file code D. These DoDAAD entries are excluded from requisition processing.
I	Interim DoDAAD entry established by the DSC. A permanent entry will be published by DAASO.
L	Local DoDAAD entry established by the DSC. A permanent entry may not be published by DAASO.
M	Military Assistance Program DoDAAD entry established by the DSC. Clear Text addresses are not permitted for these entries.
P	Permanent DoDAAD entry published by DAASO. If an interim or local entry exists, it will be replaced by the DAASO entry.
S	An address which has been suspended from requisition processing. The address can be reactivated by submitting a DIC ZGF with Type of File Code P, I, L, or M.
