PECULIAR MANAGEMENT CODES

1. Number of characters: 18.
2. Type of code: Alpha/Numeric.
3. Explanation: A field reserved for item characteristics peculiar to the needs of the individual NSNs which are not otherwise provided. For Stratification Work Sheet printouts that are requested in the Management Policy Table (021) Transaction, DIC ZTA, which is entered into the Management Policy Table (021) File, the computer will sort the first five characters of the Peculiar Management Code.
4. Source: The code is manually entered into the SCF with the Supply Management Data Change Transaction, DIC ZR2. However, for DPSC-T, the first two positions of the Peculiar Management Field of the SCF cannot be manually updated by DIC ZR2. These two positions are used for a MIG Code which is automatically updated by the internal generation of DIC ZR2 after a manual DIC ZNP is input to update the MIG Code in the NIR for a Head of Family or Bachelor item.
5. The following codes are assigned:

Any combination of 18 alpha/numerics	Each DSC will independently assign and define codes applicable to that DSC.
