LOCATION REORDER POINT CODES

1. Number of characters: One.
2. Type of code: Alpha.
3. Explanation: These Codes will be established/maintained in the NIR and will be utilized to identify item subject to review by location and provide criteria for establishing the location review level. Whenever the assets in the NIR equal to or fall below the location review level (months), a location shortage notification is passed to the SCF to generate a SSCS, appendix F-167. A Reason for Study Code PO, appendix A-156, and a Location Review Code 1 or 2, appendix A-146, are printed on line 27 of the study.
4. Source: Item Management Data Change Transaction, DIC ZJM.
5. The following codes are assigned:

<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
A	Item is not subject to location review.
B	Review level is equal to anticipated issues for one month.
C	Review level is equal to anticipated issues for two months.
D	Review level is equal to anticipated issues for three months.
E	Review level is equal to anticipated issues for four months.
F	Review level is equal to anticipated issues for five months.
G	Review level is equal to anticipated issues for six months.
H	Review level is equal to anticipated issues for seven months.
J	Review level is equal to anticipated issues for eight months.
K	Review level is equal to anticipated issues through the Procurement Lead Time (PLT).

<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
L	Review level is equal to anticipated issues through the Procurement Lead Time plus Safety Level plus OWRMRP.
M	Review level is equal to anticipated issues through the Procurement Lead Time plus Safety Level plus OWRMRP plus the Procurement cycle period less one month.
