PROVISIONING MAINTENANCE CODES

1. Number of characters: Two.
2. Type of Code: Alpha.
3. Explanation: This two-position code indicates the lowest maintenance echelon authorized to use (first position) and completely repair (second position) support items. The codes shown below are listed in ascending order from the lowest to highest echelons of maintenance.
4. Source: DoD 4140.26-M, Volume I, Chapter 4.
5. The following codes are assigned:
 - a. First position.

<u>CODE</u>	<u>EXPLANATION</u>
C	Crew or operator authorized to remove/replace the item.
O	Support item is removed, replaced, used at the organizational echelon of maintenance.
F	Support item is removed, replaced, used at the direct support echelon of maintenance.
H	Support item is removed, replaced, used at the general support echelon of maintenance.
L	Support item is removed, replaced, used at a designated Specialized Repair Activity.
D	Support item is removed, replaced, used at depot only.

- b. Second position.

<u>CODE</u>	<u>EXPLANATION</u>
O	The lowest maintenance echelon capable of complete repair of the support item is the organizational echelon.
F	The lowest maintenance echelon capable of complete repair of the support item is the direct support echelon.
H	The lowest maintenance echelon capable of complete repair of the support item is the general support echelon.
L	The lowest maintenance echelon capable of complete repair of the support item is the Special Repair Activity.

<u>CODE</u>	<u>EXPLANATION</u>
D	The lowest maintenance echelon capable of complete repair of the support item is the depot echelon.
Z	Nonrepairable. No repair is authorized.
B	No repair is authorized. The item may be reconditioned by adjusting, lubricating, etc., at the user level. No parts or special tools are procured for the maintenance of this item.
