NEW ITEM TABLE 020

1. PURPOSE

This table provides management at the DSC level with Storage Mission Codes and Preferred/Prime Distribution Activities relative to new items coded with Age of Item Code N. The Storage Mission Code and locations must be compatible with those in the Storage Mission Code Table 001, appendix F-249. The table determines where materiel will be shipped and stocked for new items. Table contains the ALT/PLT Computational Value Factor which establishes the value to use in the mechanical computational update of the Leadtime process and the ALT/PLT Parameter Factor which controls the mechanical update to the SCF and the printing of the ALT/PLT Listing (appendix F-111). This table also provides selective Fixed Safety Level Months for VIP and non-VIP Replenishment Demand items which will be input into the table, and is used in chapter 29, Quarterly Item Review Procedure. The procedure is:

- a. Quarterly reclassified from New Item status to Established Item status.
- b. Quarterly migrating from Established Medium or High Value Demand items to Low Value Demand items.
- c. Quarterly migrating from Established NSO items to Low Value Demand items.

2. ORIGIN

This report is prepared as a result of processing a Management Policy Table (MPT020) DIC ZTA, appendix B-70, as explained in chapters 38 and 56.

3. FREQUENCY

Daily, on submission of the Management Policy Table Card (table 020) DIC ZTA.

4. DATA ELEMENTS

- a. REPORT NUMBER - F34
- b. REPORT TITLE - New Item Table.
- c. PAGE NO. - Page Number of report.
- d. ORC - Output Routing Code of requester or initiator.
- e. TABLE NUMBER - 020.

- f. PRINT DATE - Date of report preparation.
- g. DSC - The DSC designators are as follows:
- T - DPSC (Clothing and Textile)
 - M - DPSC (Medical)
 - S - DPSC (Subsistence)
 - G - DGSC
 - I - DISC
 - C - DCSC
 - E - DESC
- h. FEDERAL SUPPLY CLASS - The FSCs that require selective New Item Policy. AFSC 999 entry represents the New Item Policy for the balance of the FSCs at the DSC.
- i. EAST LOCATION - Is the East Coast Location Routing Identifier Code where materiel will be positioned?
- j. EAST PERCENTAGE - Is the percentage of materiel to be positioned at the East Location?
- k. WEST LOCATION - Is the West Coast Location RIC where materiel will be positioned?
- l. WEST PERCENTAGE - Is the percentage of materiel to be positioned at the West Location?
- m. ADMINISTRATIVE LEADTIME - Is the ALT days for new items?
- n. STORAGE MISSION CODE - The code representing the Storage Mission pattern depicted in appendix F-249.
- o. SAFETY LEVEL MONTHS VIP/NON-VIP - The Safety Level Months for VIP and non-VIP items being quarterly reclassified from New Item status to Established Item status and for items quarterly migrating from Established NSC items or Medium or High Value Demand Items to Low Value Demand items. Zero filled columns are valid. This Safety Level portion of the table will be used in the Annual Item Review Procedure in chapter 29.
- p. PRODUCTION LEADTIME - Is the PLT days for new items for FSC.
- q. ALT/PLT COMPUTATIONAL VALUE FACTOR - The percentage factor for use in computing the weekly mechanical ALT/PLT updates. The norm is .67. Any deviation from the norm must be requested from DLA-OSR. A normal percentage factor of .67 and its complement .33 indicates that the latest actual ALT/PLT (leadtime of record in SCF) will be multiplied by .33 (1/3 value); the sum of these two products is the computed new average ALT/PLT for NSN.
- r. ALT/PLT PARAMETER FACTOR - This percentage factor will control the printing of the ALT/PLT listing, appendix F-111, and the mechanical update of the ALT/PLT. A norm of .50 indicates that the mechanical update of the ALT/PLT to the SCF will be suppressed when the parameters of 0.5 and 1.5 are exceeded (50 percent variance + CI -) and that an ALT-PLT listing will be generated.

s. The notification A TABLE 020 RECORDS WAS DELETED FOR KEY ELEMENT XXXX (ESC) will be printed under the columnar headings whenever the FSC has been deleted.

5. DATA ORGANIZATION

The report will be single spaced in FSC sequence. The FSC 9999 represents the balance of the DSCs New Item Policy and is the last entry in the FSC column. There will be a page break between each table.

6. NUMBER OF COPIES AND DISTRIBUTION

One copy to DSO.

7. PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW AND PROCESSING

a. This report will be reviewed to assure that the add, change, or delete action intended by input of the Management Policy Table Card processed as desired by the originator/requester.

b. The report will be retained for DSC/DLA policy reviews.

8. RETENTION PERIOD

Any report resulting from an add, change, or delete action will be filed in Table/Date sequence for a period of 12 months and then destroyed. A report generated as a result of an inquiring action can be destroyed after it has served the purpose for which it was requested.
