WEAPON SYSTEM UNIDENTIFIED NSN VIOLATIONS REPORT

1. PURPOSE

Provides the Weapon System monitors with a listing of internally generated WS1 transactions which violated because the NSN/items could not be identified in the Weapon System processes.

2. ORIGIN

The printout is prepared as a result of the Weapon Item Data Transaction, DIC WS1, appendix B-144, originating from the Provisioning process; and, an attempt to process in the Weapon System Data Base (WSDB) process after the transaction recycled at least five Requirements cycles without an NSN match. Chapter 51 applies.

3. FREQUENCY

This printout is prepared on a daily basis during the Requirements cycles whenever a transaction breaches the above stated criteria.

4. FORMAT

a. Heading Line (Standard Identification)

b. Data Organization:

(1) Sequence: Sequencing is by Weapon System Designator Code (WSDC).

(2) Number of lines per page: Variable.

(3) Spacing: Double-spaced.

(4) Page Break is on: Service and/or overflow.

(5) Required totals are: None.

c. Captions of Data Elements:

(1) DIC - Document Identifier Code.

(2) RIC (TO) - Routing Identifier Code To.

(3) NSN - National Stock Number; comprised of Federal Stock Class (FSC), North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) number and National Identification Number (NIIN).

- (4) WSEC - Weapon System Essentiality Code (appendix A-38, part I).
- (5) WSMC - Weapon System Maintenance Code (appendix A-38, part II).
- (6) WSDC - Weapon System Designator Code (appendix A-44, part I).
- (7) TRANS DATE - Transaction Date - Date that the transaction was initiated or the processing date.
- (8) TOC - Transaction Origination Code (appendix A-22).
- (9) WSAC - Weapon System Advice Code (appendix A-57, part I).
- (10) RIC (FM) - Routing Identifier Code From.

#### 5. DISTRIBUTION AND RETENTION

One copy of this printout is prepared and disseminated to Weapon System monitors according to Service designations. The printout may be disposed of after review and/or completion of actions and requirements.

#### 6. PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW AND PROCESSING

The Weapon System monitors will review the printouts, and perform the necessary research using any means/techniques available to identify those unidentified NSNs/items which emanated from the Provisioning process. The Services need not be notified in the usual automated manner (via WS3) of these violations.
