MINIMUM PROCUREMENT DELIVERY ALLOCATION FACTOR TABLE 032

1. PURPOSE

This table provides management at the DSC level with a method of eliminating multiple consignments and uneconomical consignments during computer processing for recommended procurements. This management table is only applicable to PDDs designated as consignees in procurement actions.

2. ORIGIN

This report is prepared as a result of processing a Management Policy Table (MPT032) Document DIC ZTA, appendix B-70, as explained in chapter 34.

3. FREQUENCY

Daily, on submission of the Management Policy Table (MPT032) Document DIC ZTA.

4. FORMAT

- a. Heading Line (Standard Identification).
- b. Date Organization.

This report will be single spaced in FSC sequence. The FSC 9999 represents the balance of the DSCs Minimum Procurement Delivery Policy.

c. Caption of Data Elements:

- (1) DSC - The DSC designator.

- T - DPSC (Clothing and Textile)
- M - DPSC (Medical)
- S - DPSC (Subsistence)
- G - DGSC
- I - DISC
- C - DCSC
- E - DESC

(2) FSC - Federal Supply Class. FSC 9999 represents the balance of the DSCs FSC assignment for which no individual policy is assigned.

(3) SYS UNITS - Indicates the minimum number of units required in a stock procurement action to obtain multiple destinations.

(4) SYS \$ - Indicates the minimum dollar value required in a stock procurement action to obtain multiple destinations.

(5) LOC UNITS - Indicates the minimum number of units required in a stock procurement action for a storage location to qualify as a consignee.

(6) LOC \$ - Indicates the minimum dollar value required in a stock procurement action for a storage location to qualify as a consignee.

(7) LOC % BUY - Indicates the minimum percentage of the total recommended buy required for location to be qualified consignee, e.g., an entry of 5 indicates 5 percent.

5. NUMBER OF COPIES AND DISTRIBUTION

6. PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW AND PROCESSING

a. This report will be reviewed to assure that the add, change, or delete action intended by input of the Management Policy Table Document processed as desired by the originator/requester.
