FORECAST RETURN PERCENTAGE MANAGEMENT POLICY TABLE 014 (MPT014)

1. PURPOSE

This table provides management the means for entering a Returns Forecast Adjustment Factor which can be used to adjust the System Quarterly Forecast of Returns quantity for all items when necessary. The factor will normally be 1.00 (100%).

2. ORIGIN

This report is prepared as a result of processing a Management Policy Table (MPT014) Document, DIC ZTA, appendix B-70, explained in DLAM 4140.2, Volume II, Part 1, Chapter 57.

3. FREQUENCY

Daily, on submission of the Management Policy Table (MPT014) Document, DIC ZTA.

4. DATA ELEMENTS

- a. REPORT NUMBER - F-72.
- b. REPORT TITLE - Forecast Return Percentage Table.
- c. PAGE NUMBER - Page Number of report.
- d. ORC - Output Routing Code of requester or initiator.
- e. TABLE NUMBER - 014.
- f. PRINT DATE - Date of report preparation.
- g. DSC - The DSC designators are as follows:

- T - DPSC (Clothing and Textile)
- M - DPSC (Medical)
- S - DPSC (Subsistence)
- G - DGSC
- I - DISC
- C - DCSC
- E - DESC

- h. FEDERAL SUPPLY CLASS - The FSCs that require a specific return factor. A FSC 9999 entry represents the return factor for the balance of the FSCs at the DSC.

i. RETURNS FORECAST ADJUSTMENT FACTOR - Is the factor used to adjust forecasts of returns whenever the returns are considered in the generation of recommended. This is a three position numeric factor signifying two decimal places assumed (0.05, 0.68, etc.) with 1.00 considered normal.

j. The notification A TABLE 014 RECORD WAS DELETED FOR KEY ELEMENT XXXX (FSC) will be printed under the columnar headings whenever a FSC has been deleted.

5. DATA ORGANIZATION

The report will be single spaced in Federal Supply Class Sequence. The FSC 9999 represents the balance of the DSCs policy and is the last entry in the FSC column. There will be a page break between each table.

6. NUMBER OF COPIES AND DISTRIBUTION

One copy to Directorate of Supply Operations.

7. PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW AND PROCESSING

a. This report will be reviewed to assure that the add, change or delete action intended by input of the Management Policy Table Document processed as desired by the originator/requestor.

b. The report will be retained for DSC/DLA policy reviews.

8. RETENTION PERIOD

Any report resulting from an add, change or delete action will be filed in table/date sequence for a period of 12 months and then destroyed. A report generated as a result of an inquiring action can be destroyed after it has served the purpose for which it was prepared.
