WEAPON SYSTEMS SUPPORT PROGRAM VSL AUGMENTATION

1. PURPOSE

This printout provides DSC management with statistics concerning the number of NSNs having Weapon System applications, which have undergone an end-of-quarter augmented Variable Safety Level (VSL) computation, that has increased their VSL quantities over the normally computed DoD Variable Safety Level quantities. The total dollar value (using Acquisition Unit Cost) of all such VSL increases is also listed for the whole system.

2. ORIGIN

This printout is prepared quarterly after the augmented VSL computation is performed for selected Weapon System items as depicted in DLAM 4140.2, Volume II, Part 1, Chapters 51 and 56, and Part 2, Appendix D-187.

3. FREQUENCY

Quarterly, as part of the end-of-quarter VSL computation.

4. FORMAT

a. Heading Line (Standard Identification).

b. Data Organization.

(1) Sequence: Not applicable.

(2) Number of lines per page: One.

(3) Spacing: Not applicable.

(4) Page Break is on: Not applicable.

(5) Required Totals: Each entry on the printout is already a total.

c. Captions of Data Elements.

(1) NUMBER OF NSNs IN PROGRAM - The number of NSNs in the Supply Control File which qualify for the augmented VSL computation for Weapon Systems items during end-of-quarter processing. These NSNs must have Safety Level Code V or W, applicable Weapon System Indicator Code (WSIC), appendix A-44, part II, Item Category Code 1 or P, Supply Status Code 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, or A, Age of Item Code E and Shelf-Life Code zero.

(2) NUMBER OF NSNs FOR WHICH VSL WAS AUGMENTED - The number of NSNs from among those in subparagraph (1) above for which the safety level quantity, resulting from the augmented VSL computation for Weapon Systems items, was greater than the safety level quantity resulting from the Standard DoD VSL computation. The larger augmented VSL quantities are updated to the Supply Control File (SCF).

(3) TOTAL DOLLAR VALUE OF VSL INCREASE - The total dollar value (using Acquisition Unit Cost) of the increases in VSL quantities for the NSNs in subparagraph (2) above.

5. DISTRIBUTION AND RETENTION

One copy to the Directorate of Supply Operations Management Support Office (MSO). This printout should be retained as necessary for DSC/DLA policy reviews.

6. PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW AND PROCESSING

This printout should be reviewed to determine the number of NSNs receiving increased safety level quantities because of the augmented VSL computation for Weapon Systems items, and to determine the total dollar value of all such increases. Depending on the conclusions drawn from such an analysis, the Supply Availability percentages in MPT005 and in the SCF header may be raised, or lowered on a general basis, subject to budgetary constraints and the degree of emphasis placed on Weapon Systems Supply performance.
