PROVISIONING ADVICE LIST

1. PURPOSE

This printout reflects the initial advice notification provided to submitting activities, indicating the status of Supply Support Requests (SSRs) that entered the Provisioning Subsystem. It is mandatory that this be processed within 25 days after receipt of the Provisioning Control Document (PCC) package. A Line Item Advice Document, appendix B-214, is produced for each item identified CX1 on the Provisioning Advice List. These advice documents are forwarded to the submitting activity.

2. ORIGIN

This list is generated as a result of SSRs processed by the Provisioning Subsystem.

3. FREQUENCY

Each Provisioning cycle.

4. FORMAT

a. Heading Line.

(1) REPORT NUMBER - F-209.

(2) GENERATING ACTIVITY - FROM: (The two digit alpha DSC Activity Codes).

(3) TITLE - PROVISIONING ADVICE LIST FOR -- --- ----. Will include:

(a) Activity Code (FROM) (two position).

(b) Provisioning Control Code (PCC) (three position).

(c) Date of Request (DOR) (four position).

(4) DATE - Julian date of report preparation (two position year and three position day) (five position).

(5) PAGE - Page number.

b. Data Organization:

(1) Sequence:

(a) DIC.

(b) ISN.

(2) Number of lines per page - Variable.

(3) Spacing - Double.

(4) Page break is on AC, PCC, and DOR.

(5) Required totals - None.

c. Captions and Explanation of Data Elements:

(1) DIC - Document Identifier Code (three position).

(2) ISN - Item Serial Number as contained in the original SSR (may be one to six positions).

(3) NSN or CAGE/PT NO. (WHEN APPLICABLE) - (variable length field). Self-Explanatory.

(4) ATC - Action Taken Code (two position). See DLAM 4140.2, Volume II, Part 3, Appendix A-136.

(5) REMARKS - Remarks block contains message of conditional acceptance or rejection where applicable (variable length field). Also indicates when the AAC/SSC for the item has been changed from stocked to nonstocked, by letters CHG.

(6) TDV - Total Dollar Value. Quantity times UP for those items changed from stocked to nonstocked.

(7) SSR EXCEPTIONS - Reflects the number of exceptions applicable to a specific SSR package being returned to the submitting activity. The quantity will be printed on the first line only (five position), under SSR exceptions.

One copy to PCO to be retained in the Provisioning Historical File.

6. PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW AND PROCESSING

Process IAW DLAM 4140.2, Volume II, Part 1, Chapter 4, and Part 3, Appendix E-447 P.
