FSC SEQUENCED SUPPLY EFFECTIVENESS REPORT (CIT ITEMS)
MATERIEL OBLIGATIONS ESTABLISHED

1. PURPOSE

To provide the Item Management Personnel with supply effectiveness/availability status on the Consumable Item Transfer (CIT) Federal Supply Classes for Phase I and II Items.

2. ORIGIN

Mechanically generated in the monthend process, following the F-220 output.

3. FREQUENCY

Monthly.

4. FORMAT

a. Heading Line (Standard Identification).

b. Data Organization:

(1) FSC - Sequenced in ascending order.

(2) Lines per page, varied.

(3) Double-spaced.

(4) Page Break by Federal Supply Group.

(5) Required Totals - Subtotals by the CIT (Phase I and II) items by Federal Supply Group, and a grand total at the end of report.

c. Caption of Data Elements (comparable to the F-67 report line numbers).

(1) FSC - Federal Supply Class.

(2) NET DEMANDS - Line 7b.

(3) Materiel Obligations Established.

(a) STOCK - Line 9a.

(b) DIRECT DELIVERY - Line 9b.

(c) TOTAL - (9A and 9B) Line 9C.

(4) PERCENT STOCK AVAILABILITY - 100% less Total Materiel Obligations Established, divided by Net Demands - Line 10.

(5) ERROR MESSAGE - An In-the-Clear message which states that this FSC was not found in the Policy File or that the FSC is not managed by this DSC.

5. DISTRIBUTION AND RETENTION

Output to supply personnel, discard when data has been analyzed and/or utilized for the intended purpose.

6. PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW

The IMs will analyze this report isolating those FSCs having comparatively low or erratic supply effectiveness performance. Investigations and remedial actions will need to be taken as required, to include but not limited to: Identifying and correction of problems/errors in requirements, procurement computations, administration and production lead time, allocation of stock, etc.
