MINIMUM DISPOSAL VALUE TABLE 012

1. PURPOSE

This table provides management at the DSC level with the dollar values (using Acquisition Unit Cost) which determine when disposal actions are economical and are to be manually reviewed by the IM. The dollar values can be related to either specific FSCs or to all FSCs. The Supply Control Study - Long Supply, appendix F-170, with Reason for Study Code EX, LE, NI, PE, PP, TE, or WE (appendix A-156) will be generated as a result of this policy table. DIC ZLC, Recommended Disposal Transaction, appendix B-31, will accompany Reason for Study Codes EX, PE, TE, and WE.

2. ORIGIN

This report is prepared as a result of processing a Management Policy Table (MPT012), DIC ZTA, appendix B-70, and explained in chapter 31.

3. FREQUENCY

Daily, on submission of the Management Policy Table (MPT012), DIC ZTA.

4. DATA ELEMENTS

- a. REPORT NO. - F-259.
- b. REPORT TITLE - Minimum Disposal Value Table.
- c. PAGE NO. - Page Number of report.
- d. ORC - Output Routing Code of requester or initiator.
- e. TABLE NUMBER - 012.
- f. PRINT DATE - Date of report preparation.
- g. DSC - The DSC designators are as follows:

- T - DPSC (Clothing and Textile)
- M - DPSC (Medical)
- S - DPSC (Subsistence)
- G - DGSC
- I - DISC
- C - DCSC
- E - DESC

h. FEDERAL SUPPLY CLASS - The FSCs that require selective disposal dollar values. An FSC 9999 entry represents the disposal dollar values for the balance of the FSCs at the DSC.

i. MINIMUM ECONOMICAL DISPOSAL VALUE FOR REPLENISHMENT DEMAND ITEMS - Is the dollar value (using Acquisition Unit Cost) at which the DSC considers disposal uneconomical. At present time this will be \$50 but is subject to change by DLA- OS. (Field pos. 23-28 DIC ZTH for Table 012 entry.)

j. MAXIMUM AUTOMATIC DISPOSAL VALUE - This value is not currently used.

k. MINIMUM EXCESS REVIEW VALUE FOR REPLENISHMENT DEMAND AND NSO ITEMS - Is the dollar value (using Acquisition Unit Cost) at or above which the computer will generate a DIC ZRB, appendix B-108 for stocked items other than SSC/FSSC 2, 3 or 9 for IM review of potential excess. (Field pos. 35-40 of DIC ZTA for Table 012 entry.)

l. The notification A TABLE 012 RECORD WAS DELETED FOR KEY ELEMENT XXXX (FSC) will be printed under the columnar headings whenever an FSC has been deleted.

5. DATA ORGANIZATION

The report will be single spaced in FSC sequence. The FSC 9999 represents the balance of the DSCs Disposal Dollar Value Policy and is the last entry in the FSC column. There is a page break between each table.

6. NUMBER OF COPIES AND DISTRIBUTION

One copy to DSO.

7. PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW AND PROCESSING

a. This report will be reviewed to assure that the add, change, or delete action intended by input of the Management Policy Table Transaction is processed as desired by the originator/requester.

b. The report will be retained for DSC/DLA policy reviews.

8. RETENTION PERIOD

Any report resulting from an add, change, or delete action will be filed in table/date sequence for a period of 12 months and then destroyed. A report generated as a result of an inquiring action can be destroyed after it has served the purpose for which it was requested.
