

APPENDIX F-281  
SHELF-LIFE REPORT

1. PURPOSE

To provide the DSCs with selected data for the identification, control, utilization, and disposal of Shelf-Life items.

2. ORIGIN

**The origin is Chapter 11.** Product Control Number SR(Q)281 has been assigned by the Comptroller (DLA-CM).

3. FREQUENCY

Semiannual on 31 December and 30 June.

4. FORMAT

a. Heading Line (Standard Identification).

(1) The title for parts 1 through 3 is SHELF-LIFE Report. Title for part 4 is SERVICE/AGENCY MANAGED SHELF-LIFE NSNs. Title for part 5 is DISPOSAL OF SHELF-LIFE ITEMS.

(2) Subtitles for each part are as follows (parts 2 and 5 have 2 sections each):

PART 1 - ITEM/DOLLAR VALUE SUMMARY  
PART 2 - TYPE 1 - ITEM/DOLLAR ANALYSIS  
PART 2 - TYPE 2 - ITEM/DOLLAR ANALYSIS  
PART 3 - CONDITION CODE/DOLLAR ANALYSIS  
PART 4 - WHOLESALE CONSUMABLES  
PART 5 - SHELF-LIFE ITEMS (WHOLESALE)  
PART 5 - SHELF-LIFE ITEMS (RETAIL)

b. Data Organization:

(1) Sequence:

(a) Major Sequence is by Report Part Number, i.e., parts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.

(b) Part 1 Minor sequence is by FSC.

(c) Part 2 Minor sequence is by Shelf-Life Code.

(d) Part 3 Minor sequence is by Condition Code.

(e) Part 4 Minor sequence is by FSC.

(f) Part 5 Minor sequence is by FSC.

(2) Lines per page are variable for parts 1, 4, and 5, and fixed for parts 2 and 3.

(3) Parts 1, 2, 3, and 5 are double-spaced, part 4 is single-spaced.

(4) Page break is on overflow or by report part number.

(5) Required totals are as prescribed in subparagraph c below by report part number.

c. Captions of Data Elements:

(1) PART 1 - ITEM/DOLLAR VALUE SUMMARY.

(a) FSC - Each FSC having one or more Shelf-Life NSNs is recorded.

(b) TYPE 1 - Number of Type 1 Shelf-Life NSNs within FSC.

(c) TYPE 2 - Number of Type 2 Shelf-Life NSNs within FSC.

(d) TOTAL - Total of Shelf-Life NSNs within FSC. An NSN will be recorded whether or not assets are on hand.

(e) READY FOR ISSUE - The dollar value of Shelf-Life assets on hand, within FSC, in Condition Codes A, B, and C.

(f) NOT READY FOR ISSUE - The dollar value of Shelf-Life assets on hand, within FSC, in Condition Codes D, E, F, G, and Condition Codes K and L are totaled separately, and the total of the two combined under subheading, NON-RFI TOTAL.

(g) SUSPENDED FOR TEST COND J - The dollar value of Shelf-Life assets, within FSC, suspended from issue in Condition Code J.

(h) TOTAL - The total dollar value of Shelf-Life assets, within FSC, in Condition Codes A, B, C, D, E, F, G, K, L, and J.

(i) GRAND TOTAL - Totals of subparagraph (b) through (g) data elements for all FSCs.

(2) PART 2 - TYPE 1 and TYPE 2 ITEM/DOLLAR ANALYSIS.

(a) SL CODE MONTHS - The Shelf-Life Code, appendix A-47, and the number of months Shelf-Life represented by this code.

(b) NR NSNs - The number of NSNs within each Shelf-Life Code. An NSN will be recorded whether or not assets are on hand.

(c) READY FOR ISSUE - Dollar value of assets, within Shelf-Life Code, in Condition Codes A, B, and C.

(d) NOT READY FOR ISSUE - Dollar value of assets, within Shelf-Life Code, in Condition Codes D, E, F, G, and Condition Codes K and L are totaled separately, and the total of the two combined under subheading, NON-RFI TOTAL.

(e) SUSPENDED FOR TEST COND J - Dollar value of Shelf-Life assets, within Shelf-Life Code, suspended from issue in Condition Code J.

(f) TYPE 1 TOTAL AND TYPE 2 TOTAL - Totals by Type of Item Code for each of the subparagraphs (2)(b) through (e) above data elements.

(g) GRAND TOTAL - Totals for both Types 1 and 2 data elements.

(3) PART 3 - CONDITION CODE/DOLLAR ANALYSIS.

(a) CONDITION CODE - The condition of assets on hand, appendix A-16.

(b) TYPE 1 ITEMS - Total dollar value of Shelf-Life assets, within Condition Code, on hand for Type 1 items.

(c) TYPE 2 ITEMS - Total dollar value of Shelf-Life assets, within Condition Code, on hand for Type 2 items.

(d) TOTAL - Combined dollar value, within Condition Code, for Type 1 and 2 items.

(e) GRAND TOTAL - Total dollar value of Shelf-Life assets by Type of Item, and the total value of all Shelf-Life items.

(4) PART 4 - WHOLESALE CONSUMABLES (RCS DD-M(SA)1549).

(a) MANAGING SERVICE AGENCY - Constant DLA.

(b) CP - Abbreviation of DSC preparing the report, as follows:

DSCC - Defense Supply Center Columbus  
DESC - Defense Electronics Supply Center  
DGSC - Defense General Supply Center  
DISC - Defense Industrial Supply Center  
DMSC - Defense Personnel Supply Center - Medical  
DSSC - Defense Personnel Supply Center - Subsistence  
DTSC - Defense Personnel Supply Center - Clothing and Textiles

(c) FSC - Each FSC having one or more Shelf-Life NSNs is recorded.

(d) CURRENT, NO. NSNS, \$ VALUE INVENTORY - The number of items and dollar value of inventory for all Condition Codes shown in part 1. (Should agree with part 1 total by FSC.)

(e) ADDITIONS, NO. NSNS, \$ VALUE INVENTORY - The number and dollar value of Shelf-Life Codes added since the last semiannual report. Applies when a Shelf-Life Code is added to existing NSNs as well as when new NSNs containing a Shelf-Life Code are added to the NIRF. The dollar value of inventory is recorded at the point in time that the addition occurs.

(f) DELETIONS, NO. NSNS, \$ VALUE INVENTORY - The number and dollar value of Shelf-Life Codes deleted since the last semiannual report. Applies when a Shelf-Life Code is deleted from an existing NSN as well as when an NSN containing a Shelf-Life Code is deleted from the NIRF.

(g) NET CHANGE, NO. NSNS, \$ VALUE INVENTORY - Represents the number of items and dollar value difference between the additions and deletions.

(5) PART 5 - Disposal Shelf-Life Items RCS DD-M(SA)1549.

(a) Section A - Shelf-Life Items (wholesale).

1. Managing Service/Agency - The Defense Logistics Agency.
2. ICP - Inventory Control Point (DSC).
3. FSC - The Federal Supply Class for which there was shelf-life property disposed.

(b) All Shelf-Life Items.

1. CONSUMABLE - The number of all Shelf-Life NSNs within FSC disposed.
2. \$ Value - The dollar value of all Shelf-Life NSNs that have been disposed.
3. Nonconsumable - Not applicable at this time.
4. \$ Value - Not applicable.

(c) Expired Shelf-Life Items.

1. Consumable - The number of Shelf-Life NSNs within FSC that have been disposed of for Expiration of Shelf-Life.
2. \$ Value - The dollar value of those NSNs that have been disposed of for expiration of shelf-life.
3. Nonconsumable - Not applicable at this time.
4. \$ Value - Not applicable at this time.

## 5. DISTRIBUTION AND RETENTION

Four copies to DSO. Retain in accordance with (IAW) local procedures and retire IAW DLA File Maintenance and Distribution Manual DLAM 5810.1. One copy, all five parts, is to be submitted to DLA-OSC.

## 6. PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW AND PROCESSING

a. This report will be reviewed and analyzed for the DSCs determined purpose. Condition Codes within this report are for all Purpose/Ownership Codes within the Condition Code (DLA and Service stock).

b. Part 4 of the report shall be used as a means of determining:

(1) The number of items in the Shelf-Life program at a given point in time i.e., the baseline.

(2) The program's stability or direction (trends).

(3) The characteristics of shelf-life items.

(4) The commodities or Federal Supply Classes (FSCs) requiring special attention and action.

(5) The Primary Inventory Control Activities (PICAs) or Secondary Inventory Control Activities (SICAs) responsible for the management of shelf-life items.

(6) Any other purpose deemed necessary by the DSC.

c. Part 5 of the report shall be used as a means of determining:

(1) The volume of shelf-life items entering the disposal program in terms of number of items, and dollar value of materiel.

(2) The shelf-life items, commodities, or FSCs, requiring specific attention or action.

(3) Whether disposal volume for shelf-life items is proportionately less than, equal to, or greater than disposal volumes for other than shelf-life items.

(4) The organizational level or DSC generating the disposal action.

(5) Disposal stability or direction (trends).

(6) Any other purpose deemed necessary by the DSC.

d. The DSC shall enter pertinent remarks on the report prior to submittal to DLA-OSC; e.g., if there is an unusual increase/decrease in the number of items managed or the number of items disposed. The report must be forwarded to DLA-OSC by 31 July and 31 January respectively.
