DIVERGING REQUIREMENTS FAMILY HEAD AND I&S MASTER NSNs

1. PURPOSE

To provide a listing whenever the system processes a Requirements or I&S family transaction which results in different NSNs appearing in the NIR under Requirements Family Number and I&S Master headings or it will identify the condition whereby one family is being established but not the other.

2. ORIGIN

This printout is mechanically generated whenever a DIC ZJS, Requirements Family Number change or DIC ZIS, I&S Order of Use transaction is processed that results in the condition outlined in paragraph 1 above.

3. FREQUENCY

Monthly

4. FORMAT

a. Heading Line (Standard Identification).

b. Data Organization.

(1) Sequence:

(a) Major: ORC.

(b) Minor: NSN.

(2) Number of lines per page is variable.

(3) Single-spaced.

(4) Page break is on ORC.

(5) Required Totals: None.

c. Captions of Data Elements.

(1) DIC - Document Identifier Code (ZJS or ZIS).

(2) NSN - National Stock Number - For DIC ZJS the NSN will be from pos. 40-48 and for DIC ZIS the NSN will be from pos. 4-16.

(3) RELATED NSN - For DIC ZJS this field will reflect the NSN appearing in the NIR under the I&S Master field and for DIC ZIS this field will reflect the NSN appearing under the Requirement's Family Number field. Note: When this field is blank it will indicate that one of the families is not established.

(4) ORC - Output Routing Code.

5. DISTRIBUTION AND RETENTION

One copy to the ORC on NSN reflected above. It may be destroyed after review and action.

6. PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW AND PROCESSING

This printout will be used IAW procedures outlined in E-059 P.
