RAF KEMBLE ITEM RANGE REVIEW (IRR)/CENTER

1. PURPOSE

To provide DLA, Air Force MOU and hardware DSCs with visibility of NSNs currently stocked at KEMBLE storage site. The IRR will permit the AIR FORCE, AFLC-MM to determine qualification/disqualification of stockage, based on mission essentiality. Upon determination by AFLC, RAF KEMBLE Storage Mission Patterns are updated as applicable.

2. ORIGIN

This listing is produced as a result of summarizing demand data from USAFE designated customers authorized to request supply support from RAF KEMBLE, a designated Prime Distribution Activity.

3. FREQUENCY

Annual upon submission of Storage Mission Codes (SMC) obtained from each DSC's Management Policy Table (MPT) 001. The European Distribution System (EDS) Officer is responsible for preparing and submitting Storage Mission Codes (SMCs) labeled as USRMDCPT (Storage Mission Code Data Set) to the Office of Data Systems (ODS).

4. FORMAT

a. Heading Line (Standard Identification).

b. Data Organization:

(1) Sequence:

(a) Major: By ORC.

(b) Minor: By Category and NSN within Category.

(2) Number of lines per page: Varies.

(3) Page Break: By ORC.

(4) Required Totals: By Category. Total number of NSNs, total demand frequency and total demand quantity.

c. Captions of Data Elements:

(1) Category Code - An explanation of NSNs identified to Category as explained in subparagraph 6 below.

(2) ORC - Output Routing Code.

- (3) NSN - Self-explanatory.
- (4) ICC - Item Category Code (appendix A-87).
- (5) SSC - Supply Status Code (appendix A-50).
- (6) Future SSC - Future Supply Status Code (appendix A-50).
- (7) ANN DMD (Freq) - Annual Demand Frequency.
- (8) ANN DMD (QTY) - Annual Demand Quantity.
- (9) Category__ Total NSNs - Total NSN count by category.
- (10) Category__ Total DMDs (Freq) - Annual number of demands by category.
- (11) Category__ Total DMDs (QTY) - Total quantity of demands by category.

5. DISTRIBUTION AND RETENTION

Directorate of Supply Operations - Item Manager (ORC of RECORD) - one copy to be retained until completion of review, unless otherwise directed.

6. PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW AND PROCESSING

a. Category A - These are items that are already being stocked at KEMBLE and the IRR indicates that they should remain stocked at KEMBLE. Identification of these items is for informational purposes and no action is required.

b. Category B - These are items that are not currently stocked at KEMBLE, but the IRR indicates that they should be stocked there. AFLC will review these items to determine if any of these should not be stocked at KEMBLE. AFLC will annotate in red NS next to any NSN that should not be stocked at KEMBLE. DSCs will process as follows:

(1) NS Items - No action.

(2) Others - Add RAF KEMBLE to the stockage pattern and take appropriate supply action IAW EDS stockage procedures. The EDS Officer will apprise the Item Manager to enter/or destroy PRDA transactions if applicable.

c. Category C - These are items that are currently stocked at RAF KEMBLE, but the IRR indicates that demands are not sufficient to continue stockage. AFLC will review these items to determine if any of these items should still be stocked at KEMBLE. DSCs will process as follows:

(1) S Items - No action.

(2) Others - Delete RAF KEMBLE from the stockage pattern. The EDS Officer will apprise the Item Manager to enter/or destroy PRDA transactions if applicable.

d. After the above actions, DSCs will manually compute the following information and provide to DLA-OSC. Information copies will be provided to AFLC-MM and USAFE-LGS. (The Item Manager will receive further instructions from EDS Officer.)

(1) Number of NSNs remaining stocked at KEMBLE and total USAFE annual demands.

(2) Number of NSNs added to KEMBLE and total USAFE annual demands.

(3) Number of NSNs deleted from KEMBLE stockage and total USAFE annual demands.

(4) Total number of NSNs stocked at KEMBLE and total USAFE annual demands.

e. The schedule for the IRR is:

(1) DSCs run IRR - NLT 15 Jan (D-Day).

(2) DSCs furnish listings to AFLC - five working days after IRR (D+5).

(3) AFLC return annotated listings to DSCs - ten working days after receipt (D+15).

(4) DSCs complete required actions - ten working days after receipt (D+25).

(5) DSCs provide required statistical data - five working days after completion of required actions (D+30).
