UPDATED/INTERROGATED TABLES LIST

1. PURPOSE

To provide a listing of the data elements contained in the Technical Subsystem Policy Tables. The Directorate of Supply Operations (DSO) is responsible for maintaining the Provisioning New Item Table 22 and the Stock/Nonstock Table 24.

2. ORIGIN

This listing is output mechanically as a result of processing a change to the Provisioning New Item Table 22. This listing may also be obtained by preparing and processing the Provisioning New Item and Stock/Nonstock Table Transaction, DIC YBE. The format of this transaction is depicted in appendix B-378.

3. FREQUENCY

The listing will be output daily as a result of processing DIC YBE to inquiry or update a Technical Subsystem Table.

4. FORMAT

a. Heading Line: Standard Identification.

b. Data Organization:

(1) Sequence:

(a) Major - Table Number.

(b) Minor - Number of Items.

(2) Number of lines per page: Variable.

(3) Spacing: Single-Spaced.

(4) Page break: On change of Table or overflow.

(5) Required totals: None.

c. Captions of Data Elements:

(1) TABLE 22

(a) TBLNO - Table Number is a numeric representing the Technical Subsystem Policy Table being reflected.

(b) NO OF ITEMS - Number of Items is a numeric that identifies an individual record within a table.

(c) The numeric representing data position indicators will be reflected on a line of data. The data elements applicable to Table 22, as described in appendix B-378, will be reflected on a line of data below the position indicators. The data elements applicable to Table 22 are depicted as follows:

1. Positions 1-4 - The administrative cost of low value procurement.

2. Positions 5-8 - The administrative cost of high value procurement.

3. Positions 9-12 - The receipt cost.

4. Positions 13-14 - The holding rate cost.

5. Positions 15-18 - The cost of issuing stock.

6. Positions 19-22 - The shortage cost.

7. Positions 23-24 - The buying on demand premium.

8. Positions 25-48 - Each two-position numeric represents the probability of demand occurring in two years for a specific frequency of demand. Frequency of demands of 1 through 12 are represented.

9. Positions 49-51 - The surcharge rate.

(2) TABLE 24

(a) TBLNO - Table Number is a numeric representing the Technical Subsystem Policy Table being reflected.

(b) NO OF ITEMS - Number of Items is a numeric that represents the number of months Production Leadtime (PLT). PLTs of 1 through 15 will be reflected. Any Supply Support Request (SSR) reflecting more than 15 months PLT will be matched to the values in the table for a PLT of 15.

(c) The numeric representing data position indicators will be reflected on a line of data. The data elements applicable to Table 24 will be reflected on a line of data below the position indicators. The data elements for each PLT reflected are derived from the computation of the Stock/Nonstock formula. The data elements applicable to Table 24 are as follows:

1. Position 10 - The replenishment quantity from a SSR with an Annual Dollar Value of Demand between \$ 0.00 and \$ 100.00 needed to qualify for stockage as an Acquisition Advice Code (AAC) D.

2. Position 20 - The replenishment quantity from a SSR with an Annual Dollar Value of Demand between \$ 101.00 and \$ 500.00 needed to qualify for stockage as an Acquisition Advice Code (AAC) D.

3. Position 30 - The replenishment quantity from a SSR with an Annual Dollar Value of Demand between \$ 501.00 and \$ 2500.00 needed to qualify for stockage as an Acquisition Advice Code (AAC) D.

4. Position 40 - The replenishment quantity from a SSR with an Annual Dollar Value of Demand between \$ 2501.00 and \$ 12,500.00 needed to qualify for stockage as an Acquisition Advice Code (AAC) D.

5. Position 50 - The replenishment quantity from a SSR with an Annual Dollar Value of Demand between \$ 12,501.00 and \$ 62,500.00 needed to qualify for stockage as an Acquisition Advice Code (AAC) D.

6. Position 60 - The replenishment quantity from a SSR with an Annual Dollar Value of Demand between \$ 62,501.00 and \$ 125,000.00 needed to qualify for stockage as an Acquisition Advice Code (AAC) D.

5. DISTRIBUTION AND RETENTION

Two copies of this listing will be forwarded to the Logistics Program Division (LPD) in the Directorate of Supply Operations (DSO). One copy of the listing may be forwarded, upon request, to DLA-OSR. One copy will be retained until it is superseded by a more recent listing.

6. PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW AND PROCESSING

The listing will be reviewed by DSO, LPD, to ensure that the annual demand frequencies reflected in the Stock/Nonstock Table 24 are within acceptable limits. If changes are deemed necessary, prepare a New Item and Stock/Nonstock Table Transaction, DIC YBE, in the format of appendix B-378, to update the values in the Technical Subsystem New Item Table 22. The changes to any value entered in the Provisioning New Item Table 22 will cause the demand frequencies reflected in the Stock/Nonstock Table 24 to be mechanically recomputed. Changes to the Provisioning New Item Table 22 will automatically generate an output of the new Stock/Nonstock Table 24 for review.
