WEAPON SYSTEM SUMMARY STATUS REPORT TRANSACTION

1. This document consists of two transactions, applicable to chapter 51, and is mechanically generated from the Distribution Subsystem at monthend from the Weapon System Master File (WSMF) for AUTODIN transmission to HQ DLA, ATTN: DLA- DLA-OPL for use in Reports Control System (RCS) DLA(M)516(O), Status of Selected Weapon System Report, for generation of the F-112 Report, and for monthly refreshment/update of the Weapon System Data Base (WSDB); and on a monthly/ weekly basis for generation of the F-112A and the F-112B Reports to update the WSDB File records. The F-112A/F-112B are furnished for monthly/weekly update of the WSDB File only and where Personal Computer (PC) access/print options exist for viewing/printing of these reports.
