

APPENDIX E-005 P

REDISTRIBUTION ORDER

1. PURPOSE

This appendix provides instructions for manual preparation of Redistribution Order, DICs A2A and A2E, appendix B-5. This document is used by DSCs to transfer stocks between distribution depots as prescribed in chapter 41.

3. RESPONSIBLE ORGANIZATIONAL ELEMENT

The appropriate Commodity Branch within the DSO is responsible for preparation of the redistribution order. However, when a FILL deficiency exists at a Specialized Support Point (SSP), a Redistribution Order, DIC A2A, will be mechanically generated when sufficient system issuable assets are available for redistribution. A A2A will also be mechanically generated whenever Condition Code A or B materiel is picked up at an attrition site and the item has either backorders, dues-in, or a Demand Value Code of E or Z (i.e., SSC 2, 3, or 9); or the NSN has no backorders, no dues-in, a Demand Value Code of other than E or Z, and the on-hand assets are less than the MAP Reimbursable Level multiplied by 2.

4. PROCEDURES/INSTRUCTIONS

- a. Processing personnel will determine the need for redistributing stocks based on monthly review of an SSCS with Reason for Study Code PO, appendix A-156.

b. When decision to redistribute stocks has been made, processing personnel will prepare a Redistribution Order Document, DIC A2A. Quantity changes may be made.

c. Where applicable, the Redistribution Order will be corrected or initiated in the format of appendix B-5. All Redistribution Orders to the SSPs will contain Project Code 1R2.

d. DLA Form 934 will be used with DIC A2E IAW appendix E-515 P and appendix B-5.

e. DIC A2A/A2E will be forwarded to the Information Processing Center and used as input to the system for mechanical preparation of a Due-In record and a Prepositioned Materiel Receipt Document, DIC DWK, appendix B-19.

f. Redistribution Orders are restricted to only those DLA-owned assets recorded in Ownership/Purpose Code A and Condition Code of A, B, C, D, E, F, or G.

g. Redistribution Order to cover the FILL deficiency include only Ownership/Purpose Code A and Condition Code A assets available for redistribution after assets applicable SSDs NN_/ NO_ are subtracted.

h. Redistribution Order to cover redistributions from attrition sites include Condition Code A or B, Ownership/Purpose Code A assets, for those NSNs having either backorders, dues-in, or a Demand Value Code of E or Z (i.e., SSC 2, 3, or 9); or those NSNs having no backorders, no due-in or a Demand Value Code of other than E or Z, and the total on-hand assets are less than the MAP reimbursable level multiplied by 2. The materiel will be picked up at attrition sites under DICs D6_, D8_, D8F emanating from DICs DEE/DEF, and D9_(X) reversals (except D9F). The actual A2A will be mechanically generated with all of the appropriate entries, except pos. 45-50, which will be left blank. This will enable the IM to redistribute to the most logical depot. The IM should be aware that quantity in pos. 25-29 of the mechanically prepared A2A may have been reduced in the interim by mechanical release of stock to satisfy backorders or requisitions. The IM will determine the current asset position from the NIR before taking supply action. The IM can adjust the quantity in pos. 25-29 whenever movement of a greater or lesser amount of stock is required. The IM will also reduce/cancel pending purchase as appropriate.
