WAR RESERVE HISTORY FILE/INQUIRY DOCUMENT VIOLATIONS

1. INPUT DOCUMENTS

- a. Appendix B-65, War Reserve History File/Inquiry Document, DIC ZSD.
- b. The War Reserve Master File.

2. INPUT TO PROCEDURE DECISION CHARTS

- a. War Reserve History File/Inquiry Document.
- b. Violation Control/Suspense File Process.

3. PURPOSE, CONTENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

a. This appendix is applicable to chapter 59, The War Reserve Program, and provides both the establishment of the War Reserve History File (WRHF) from the working War Reserve Master File (WRMF) at computations, and the daily capability of inquiry of the current WRHF. Appendix B-65, War Reserve History File/Inquiry Document, DIC ZSD, can request printouts of the files by individual NSN record or a dump of the entire file on the appendix F-330, War Reserve History File printout IAW the indicated Action Codes, appendix A-42.

b. Inquiry requests failing to pass initial validation/edit criteria when processing through the War Reserve History File/Inquiry process, will violate to the ORC of the requester reflecting the applicable Violation Reason Code (VRC), appendix A-82 causing the violation. These violations will be processed for reentry and IAW the processing procedures in appendix E-065 P and those herein. The Violation Reason Codes applicable to this process are listed in alphabetical order and defined below and in appendix A-82.

AA	DIC Invalid.
AC	RIC to Invalid, Blank, or Unmatched.
CF	Action Code Invalid or Blank.
I4	ORC Missing or Invalid.
JP	Request Data Invalid.
OG	Mass Cancellation/System Inquiry Verification Request.
WF	NSN Not in Master File.

4. PROCESSING/RESEARCH INSTRUCTIONS

a. VRC AA.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates the DIC, pos. 1-3, is other than ZSD filled.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The requester will research and correct the erroneous DIC. Reenter the corrected document as described in the Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

b. VRC AC.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates the DSC, pos. 4-6, is invalid, not the RIC of the processing DSC, or blank.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The requester will correct pos. 4-6 so that the RIC is the RIC of that processing DSC. Reenter a corrected document as described in the Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

c. VRC CF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates the Action Code, pos. 79-80, is invalid, blank, and other than AC.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The requester will correct pos. 79-80 so that the Action Code in the request transaction is AC. Reenter a corrected document as described in the Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

d. VRC I4.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates the ORC, pos. 77-78, is either invalid or blank, or for inquiries with pos. 32 a T, is other than 94 for file dump.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The requester will correct the ORC for invalid or blank fields in the transaction, or for file dump requests the correct ORC is 94 with proper authorization. Reenter the corrected document(s) as described in the Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

e. VRC JP.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that no data is requested in either pos. 32 or in pos. 8-20 of the inquiry transaction.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The requester will research to determine what the original request was intended for the transaction. Reenter a corrected document as described in the Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

f. VRC OG.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates the request for a system file dump requires appropriate authorization/verification of the need for a file dump.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The monitor will obtain an IOM of authorization for the file dump to accompany the reentry of the request which also must be from the monitor only (ORC 94). Reenter the document with authorizing IOM for processing as described in the Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

g. VRC WF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates the NSN inquiry requested has no matching record in the WRHF.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED.

The requester will research to determine if the NSN in pos. 8-20 is the correct, desired file record requested. If the NSN is incorrect, change pos. 8-20 to the correct NSN. If the NSN is correct and no file exists, clear the controlled violations from the VCSF. Reenter the corrected document or clear the VCSF as described in the Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

5. REENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

The responsible processing personnel will obtain the correcting data elements/information for the cause of violations and review the remaining data elements/information in the transaction to detect/preclude further future invalid data violations upon reentry. Correct violated data and any suspect invalid data discovered in review. Unresolved violations/data will require clearing of the controlled violation from the Violation Control/Suspense File to preclude and outstanding or hung control numbers. Reenter corrected data via the Option Code 1 method for mechanical violation processing. The following in conjunction with above criteria, are reentry instructions.
