1. INPUT DOCUMENT

Appendix B-84, Size Tariff Maintenance Document, DIC ZRT.

2. INPUT PROCEDURE CHART

Daily Additions, Changes, Deletions, and Inquiries to the Size Tariff File.

3. PURPOSE, CONTENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This appendix is applicable to chapter 25 and provides instructions for the research, correction, and reentry of Size Tariff Maintenance Documents, DIC ZRT, which have been rejected from computer processing. Reasons for computer rejection, by VRC, in alphabetical order, are listed below. The IM, Directorate of Clothing and Textiles, Defense Personnel Support Center, is responsible for processing these VRCs.

4. PROCESSING/RESEARCH INSTRUCTIONS

a. VRC AC.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that the input Routing Identifier Code (RIC), pos. 4-6, is not S9T.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Enter S9T and prepare for reentry IAW paragraph 5.

b. VRC AJ.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

(a) Indicates that a Size Tariff Maintenance Document with Action Code TJ in pos. 79-80 reflects a Procurement Group Code (PGC), pos. 22-26, which:

1. Contains characters other than all numerics greater than zero and less than 05000.

2. Contains a value which does not match a record in the Size Tariff File.

(b) Indicates that a Size Tariff Maintenance Document with Action Code TA in pos. 79-80 reflects a PGC, pos. 22-26, which:

1. Contains characters other than all numerics greater than zero and less than 5000.

2. Contains a value which does not match a record in Management Policy Table (MPT) 011.

(c) Indicates that a Size Tariff Maintenance Document with Action Code TB, TC, TD, TE, TF, or TK in pos. 79-80 reflects a Tariff Identification, pos. 22-28, which does not match a record in the Size Tariff File.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

(a) The Violation Document provides the original action as it appeared when the PGC/Tariff Identification error was detected. Check pos. 22-28.

(b) Processing personnel will review the Violation Output Document to detect and correct any obvious format errors. If correction cannot be made, refer to the documents which were the basis for the original action. Enter the appropriate PGC/Tariff Identification, referring to appendices A-116, F-89, and F-116. Prepare reentry as outlined in paragraph 5.

c. VRC AY.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that a Size Tariff Maintenance Document has been received with an invalid NSN in pos. 8-20.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

(a) The Violation Document provides the original NSN error as it appeared when the violation was detected. Check the NSN field, pos. 8-20.

(b) Processing personnel will determine the correct NSN by referring to the documents which were the basis for the original input. Prepare the reentry as outlined in paragraph 5.

d. VRC A3.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that a Size Tariff Maintenance Document with Action Code TD or TE in pos. 79-80 reflects an invalid Size Sequence Indicator (other than all numerics greater than all zeros) in pos. 29-31.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

(a) The Violation Document provides the original Size Sequence Indicator error as it appeared when the violation was detected. Check the Size Sequence Indicator field, pos. 29-31.

(b) Processing personnel will review the Violation Output Document to detect and correct any obvious format errors. If corrections cannot be made, refer to the documents which were the basis for the original action. Determine the correct Size Sequence Indicator and prepare reentry as outlined in paragraph 5.

e. VRC CF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that the Action Code entered in pos. 79-80 of the Size Tariff Maintenance Document is other than TA, TB, TC, TD, TE, TF, TG, TH, TJ, or TK.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

(a) The Violation Document provides the original Action Code as it appeared when the violation was detected. Check the Action Code field, pos. 79-80.

(b) Processing personnel will review the Violation Output Document to detect and correct any obvious format errors. If correction cannot be made, refer to the documents which were the basis for the original action. Determine the correct Action Code and prepare reentry as outlined in paragraph 5.

f. VRC I4.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

(a) If the Action Code is TA or TB in pos. 79-80, this VRC indicates an invalid Output Routing Code (other than alphanumerics) in pos. 51-52.

(b) If the Action Code is TG or TH, this VRC indicates that the ORC in pos. 77-78 is other than numeric.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

(a) If the Action Code is TA or TB, check the Output Routing Code field, pos. 51-52, as shown on the Violation Document. Determine the correct alphanumeric ORC and prepare reentry as outlined in paragraph 5.

(b) If the Action Code is TG or TH, check the ORC of requester in pos. 77-78 as shown on the Violation Document. Determine the appropriate numeric ORC and prepare reentry as outlined in paragraph 5.

g. VRC OG.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that a DIC ZRT with Action Code TG or TH has been identified in the Entry Process as an action for which verification is required. VRC OG will always be output on a Controlled Violation Listing, appendix F-122.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The Chief MSO, DSO, will determine whether or not there is an IOM for the inquiry requested.

(a) If there is an IOM, it will be forwarded to the ODS. Specific format and data elements will be checked and validated and reentry action accomplished for further processing by using Reentry Code ER.

(b) If there is no IOM, determine if the requirement is valid. If so, prepare an IOM for the signature of the MSO Chief/Deputy with all pertinent facts relating to the requirement and forward same to the ODS along with the F-122 listing annotated with Reentry Code ER. If the requirement is not valid, annotate the F-122 listing with Reentry Code D and forward to ODS for necessary delete action.

h. VRC VX.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that a Size Tariff Maintenance Document reflects an invalid Service Code (other than A0, F0, M0, N0, Z0, A3, F3, M3, or N3) in pos. 27-28 of the Tariff Identification field.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

(a) The Violation Document provides the original Service Code as it appeared when the violation was detected. Check the Service Code field, pos. 27-28.

(b) Processing personnel will review the Violation Output Document to detect and correct any obvious format errors. If correction cannot be made, refer to the documents which were the basis for the original action. Determine the correct Service Code and prepare reentry as outlined in paragraph 5.

i. VRC WF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

(a) Indicates that a Size Tariff Maintenance Document with Action Code TD in pos. 79-80 reflects an NSN in pos. 8-20 which does not match an NSN recorded under the Procurement Group Code (PGC) reflected in pos. 22-26 in Management Policy Table (MPT) 011.

(b) Indicates that a Size Tariff Maintenance Document with Action Code TE or TF in pos. 79-80 reflects an NSN in pos. 8-20 which does not match an NSN recorded under the Tariff Identification reflected in pos. 22-28 in the Size Tariff File.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

(a) The Violation Document provides the original NSN as it appeared when the violation was detected. Check the NSN field, pos. 8-20.

(b) Processing personnel will review the Violation Output Document to detect and correct any obvious format errors. If correction cannot be made, refer to the documents which were the basis for the original action. Determine the correct NSN and prepare reentry as outlined in paragraph 5.

j. VRC WQ.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that a Size Tariff Maintenance Document with Action Code TD in pos. 79-80 reflects an NSN which is already recorded under the Tariff Identification reflected in pos. 22-28 in the Size Tariff File.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

(a) The Violation Document provides the original NSN as it appeared when the violation was detected. Check the NSN field, pos. 8-20.

(b) Processing personnel will review the documents which were the basis for the original action to determine why an attempt was made to add an NSN already recorded on the Size Tariff File. If some other action was intended, prepare reentry as outlined in paragraph 5. If action was input in error, discard violation.

k. VRC 8Y.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that a Size Tariff Maintenance Document with Action Code TD or TE in pos. 79-80 reflects either a nonnumeric Initial Issue Manual Tariff Value in pos. 40-44 and/or a nonnumeric Replenishment Demand Manual Tariff Value in pos. 45-49.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

(a) The Violation Document provides the original Initial Issue and Replenishment Demand Manual Tariff Values as they appeared when the violation was detected. Check the Initial Issue Manual Tariff field, pos. 40-44, or the Replenishment Demand Manual Tariff Value, pos. 45-49, or both fields, as applicable.

(b) Processing personnel will review the Violation Output Document to detect and correct obvious format errors. If corrections cannot be made, refer to the documents which were the basis for the original action. Determine the correct Tariff Value(s) and prepare reentry as outlined in paragraph 5.

5. REENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

a. Review remaining data elements contained in violation output to detect any other invalid data and correct as necessary.

b. Reentry methods for violations are contingent upon type of violation. Type of output is an option recorded in ORC Table (appendix F-20). The following codes are the various options with their reentry instructions.

3	Uncontrolled Violation, appendix F-117	Reentry, when required, is accomplished as prescribed in appendix E-346 P.
