SUSPENSION FROM MOV REQUEST DOCUMENTS VIOLATIONS

1. INPUT DOCUMENT

Appendix B-86, Suspension from Materiel Obligation Validation (MOV) Request Document, DIC ZMF, and appendix B-270, Receipt Confirmation for MOV Request, DIC AP9/X.

2. INPUT TO PROCEDURE DECISION CHART

Processing of Backorder Validation Removal or Reinstate/Suspense Documents and Preparation of Followup Backorder Validation Request Documentation.

3. PURPOSE, CONTENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This appendix is applicable to chapter 42 and provides instructions for the research, correction, and reentry of Suspension from MOV Request Documents, DIC ZMF, and Receipt Confirmation for MOV Request, DIC AP9/X, which have been rejected from computer processing. Reasons for computer rejection by VRC are listed below. The Stock Control Division, DSO, is responsible for processing these VRCs.

<u>VIOLATION REASON CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
BJ	Supplementary Address Invalid.
CF	Action Code Invalid.
EL	Communications Distribution Code (CDC) Invalid or Missing - Code not in Record.
ET	Requisitioner Invalid.
8N	Unmatched to Backorder Validation File.

4. PROCESSING/RESEARCH INSTRUCTIONS

a. VRC BJ.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

VRC BJ indicates that the input suspension document does not match the Backorder File on Supplementary Address (pos. 45-50) for DICs ZMF and AP9/X input.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Determine from the source document that acknowledges receipt of Backorder Validation Request, DIC AP9/X, appendix B-270, the correct Supplementary Address to be used.

b. VRC CF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

VRC CF indicates that the Action Code in pos. 7-8 is not JT (see appendix A-42).

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Determine whether or not the input action, prepared IAW appendix E-086 P, is intended to remove an activities backorder from the Backorder Validation Cycle, without cancellation actions. When this action is intended Action Code JT is applicable.

c. VRC EL.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

VRC EL indicates that the input suspension document does not match the Backorder File on CDC (pos. 54) for DICs ZMF and AP9/X input.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Determine from the source document that acknowledges receipt of Backorder Validation Requests, DIC AP9/X, appendix B-270, the correct CDC to be used.

d. VRC ET.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

VRC ET indicates that the input suspension document does not match the Backorder File on Activity Address Code (pos. 30-35) for DICs ZMF and AP9/X input.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Determine, from the source document that acknowledges receipt of Backorder Validation Requests, DIC AP9, appendix B-270, the correct AAC to be used.

e. VRC 8N.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

VRC 8N indicates that the interrogation Response DIC APX does not match to any Batch Control Number recorded in the Backorder Validation File.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Review the Backorder Validation Request Listing, appendix F-243, for correct batch number. If this APX is from a previous phase of the validation cycle, destroy it.

5. REENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

a. Review remaining data elements contained in violation output to detect any other invalid data and correct as necessary.

b. Reentry methods for violations are contingent upon type of violation output. Type of output is an option recorded in the Output Routing Code Table (see appendix F-20). The following codes are the various options with reentry instructions:

<u>CODE</u>	<u>OUTPUT</u>	<u>REENTRY</u>
1	ZLR - Controlled Violation Listing - appendix F-122	Corrected data and/or reentry code (appendix A-62) will be entered on appendix F-122 with colored pencil or ink and submitted as prescribed in appendix E-066 P.
3	Uncontrolled Violation Listing - appendix F-117	Reentry, when required, will be accomplished via development of a complete new input source document with correct data as prescribed in appendix E-346 P.
