

APPENDIX E-098 P

WAR MATERIEL PRODUCTION CAPABILITY (WMPC) DOCUMENT

1. PURPOSE

This procedure is applicable to chapter 59 and describes the processing of the WMPC Documents, appendix B-98, DIC ZRM in the monthend process and in the yearly process during the War Reserve annual computation. This document may be initiated by the DSO and/ or the DP&P on a monthly basis to add/change/delete/query WMPC records of items as required IAW applicable action codes, appendix A-42. The required actions printout on appendix F-171 Report. During an annual computation the ZRM is initiated in the annual processes by DP&P from annotated appendix F-171 Report or documents prepared through the War Reserve Individual DIC/Consolidated WMR, Service Administrative Allocation Factors, and WMPC Computations process or by the War Reserve monitor in the MSO. When the WMPC is updated in the annual process, it becomes a part of the annual War Reserve History File. When the WMPC update results from a monthend process, it updates only DP&P and SCF records. This transaction will also be used during the Logistic Reassignment process to move WMPC data from the LIM to the GIM.

3. RESPONSIBLE ORGANIZATIONAL ELEMENTS

The DSO in conjunction with DP&P are responsible for the documents and/or processes of the ZRM during the monthly War Materiel Production Capability (WMPC) Monthly Maintenance/Control process. The War Reserve monitor in conjunction with DP&P is responsible for the ZRM processing in the annual computational War Reserve Individual DIC/Consolidated, WMR, Service Administrative Allocation Factors, and WMPC Computations process.

4. PROCEDURES/INSTRUCTIONS

a. During the monthend update/query process, the responsible processing personnel, either the IM in DSO or the DP&P personnel, will manually prepare instruction sheets DIC ZRM, appendix B-98 or annotated appendix F-171, with the applicable action code, appendix A-42, and process valid transactions in the monthly process. All adds, changes, delete and queries will process and printout on appendix F-171A with applicable action codes. In this process documents will be violated to the originator reflecting the VRC, appendix A-82, which caused the reject for correction and/or reentry IAW appendix E-098 V. Action code LA is a file dump and is therefore restricted to authorized personnel in the MSO only. Action codes LA and LB are single document entries; action codes LC, LD and LF are two document processes.

b. During an annual computation the War Reserve monitor and/or the DP&P responsible personnel prepare instruction sheets, DIC ZRM, appendix B-98 or annotated appendix F-171 listing, with applicable action codes, appendix A-42, and input to the ODS for processing in the annual appendix process. Transactions not passing validation/edit, will violate to ORC 94, the monitor, with applicable VRC, appendix A-82, for correction, coordination with DP&P, and reentry IAW appendix E-098 V into the annual process by the monitor. All valid update will record in the SCF, in the new, annual War Reserve History File, and printout on appendices F-171B, F-171C and F-171D (C&T only). The NSN with Planned Production Code (PPC) Y is a formally planned item and printout on appendix F-171B. Those with PPC N are informally planned items and printout on appendix F-171C. At DPSC-T, Clothing and Textiles for PPC Y sized items only, the appendix F-171D will be printed in one copy for the monitor to file with the Generic NSN containing the WMR of the NSNs in the sized PGC which rolled to make the Generic End-Item WMPC.

c. For appendix F-171A, whenever P-Day for an NSN exceeds the D+6 month, coordination/review/update by DSO and DP&P personnel will be accomplished and the file record printouts will show an XX in the action code field of the F-171A listing for these items.
