1. INPUT DOCUMENT

Appendix B-105, Item War Reserve Study/Totals Files Inquiry Document, DIC ZSB.

2. INPUT TO PROCEDURE DECISION CHARTS

None.

3. PURPOSE, CONTENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This appendix is applicable to chapter 59, The War Reserve Program, and provides the capability of daily inquiries for printout of data contained in the Item War Reserve Study File (IWRSF) and in the Item War Reserve Totals File (IWRTF). The DIC ZSB, Item War Reserve Study/Totals Files Inquiry Document, appendix B-105 to produce the appendix F-176, Item War Reserve Study printout IAW the type of printout requested and in conjunction with the applicable Action Code, appendix A-42. Violations resulting from edit/ validation will be processed by the initiator with the applicable Violation Reason Code (VRC), appendix A-82, for review/resolution/ processing IAW processing procedures in this appendix. The Violation Reason Codes applicable to this process are listed in alphabetical order and defined below and in appendix A-82.

4. PROCESSING/RESEARCH INSTRUCTIONS

a. VRC AA.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that the DIC in pos. 1-3 is other than ZSB filled.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The initiator will research and correct the erroneous DIC and reenter the corrected document as described in the Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

b. VRC AC.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates the DSC in pos. 4-6 is invalid or blank.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The monitor will correct the input by placing the RIC of the processing DSC in pos. 4-6 and reenter the corrected document as described in the Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

c. VRC CF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that the Action Code in pos. 79-80 is invalid, blank or other than AC.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The monitor will correct the Action Code in pos. 79-80 by placing AC in the field and reenter the corrected document as described in the Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

d. VRC I4.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that the ORC in pos. 77-78 is invalid or blank, or unauthorized requester.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The monitor will correct the ORC field by placing corrected numeric values in pos. 77-78 and reenter the corrected document as described in the Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

e. VRC WF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that there is no matching file record for the data requested in either the IWRSF or the IWRTF.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The monitor will research to determine if the requested data elements are correct and if the desired data elements are correct on the input transaction. Reenter a corrected document as described in the Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

f. VRC 8B.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Indicates that the data combination is invalid for inquiry request being input.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

The monitor will research the input to determine if, for C&T, and NSN request without applicable MIIG: if, at C&T, request for an FSC summary is not authorized; or if, for C&T, request is for a PGC/MIIG summary that has an incorrect commodity code. The monitor will determine the invalid data combinations and correct the appropriate data fields. Reenter the corrected document as described in Reentry Instructions in paragraph 5, below.

5. REENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

The monitor/responsible processing personnel will obtain the corrected data elements for those which caused the document violation and additionally review the remaining data elements contained in the transaction to detect/preclude further future invalid data violations upon reentry. Correct violated data and any detected suspect invalid data corrections will be prepared. Unresolved violations will be cleared from the Violation Suspense Control File to preclude any control numbers from being hung and therefore outstanding in the VSCF. Reenter corrected documents IAW with instructions for SAMMSTEL Verb SVRR found in DLAH 4745.2, Volume I, Part 1, Chapter 3.
