FEDERAL SUPPLY CLASS (FSC)/ROUTING IDENTIFIER CODE (RIC)  
MAINTENANCE DOCUMENT

1. PURPOSE

This procedure describes the method for preparing an add, change, or delete action against the FSC/RIC Routing Table. In addition, the ability exists to request printout of the entire table. Updating of the table will take place when HQ DLA publishes changes to appendix A-119.

2. APPENDICES USED IN THIS PROCESS

- a. Appendix A-119, Federal Supply Class (FSC)/Routing Identifier Code (RIC) Table.
- b. Appendix B-200, Federal Supply Class (FSC)/Routing Identifier Code (RIC) Maintenance Document.
- c. Appendix F-206, FSC Table Printout.

3. RESPONSIBLE ORGANIZATIONAL ELEMENTS

The Materiel Support Branch, Management Support Office, Directorate of Supply Operations or its counterpart at DSCP is responsible for processing input and output of this policy table.

4. PROCEDURES

- a. The FSC/RIC Maintenance Document is prepared as outlined in appendix B-200. The following are the mandatory card columns for Action Codes AA and AB.

b. Whenever Action Code AA or AB is assigned to accomplish an action, a printout of the complete file will be created. This printout to ORC 94 will be in the format of appendix F-206 and will be used to determine if the desired action took place.

c. To obtain a printout of the table, Action Code AC will be utilized. The printout (appendix F-206) will be used to ensure that the table and appendix A-119 are in agreement. Any discrepancies found will be immediately corrected either by updating the table or requesting HQ DLA to review appendix A-119.
