3. PURPOSE, CONTENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This appendix provides instructions for the research and correction of an input to establish, change, or delete data to or from the FEDSTRIP - FSC Support Table (appendix F-142) which has been rejected from computer processing. Reasons for computer rejection by VRCs in alphabetical order are listed below. The Materiel Support Branch, MSO, DSO or its DPSC counterpart is responsible for processing all VRCs.

4. PROCESSING/RESEARCH INSTRUCTIONS

a. VRC AC.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

VRC AC indicates that the RIC in pos. 4-6 was other than alpha/numeric, blank, or other than S9C, S9E, S9G, S9I, S9M, S9S, or S9T.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

This should be the RIC of the DSC (commodity identification) processing the transaction; therefore, annotate the reentry document with the correct RIC and reentry code. Reenter IAW paragraph 5.

b. VRC CF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

VRC CF indicates that an Action Code other than AA, AB, or AC has been assigned to pos. 79-80 of input cards (appendix B-201).

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Processing personnel will obtain the correct Action Code from copy of the coding document, appendix A-42, or other source data from which the original Action Code was determined.

c. VRC K2.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

VRC K2 indicates that the FEDSTRIP - FSC Support Table is full, 150 FSC entries against a specific activity or Federal Agency. Additional data cannot be added until corresponding data is deleted.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Obtain a FEDSTRIP - FSC Support Table Printout, appendix F-142, IAW appendix E-201 P. Review printout and source of rejected input. When replacement of existing table entries is necessary, prepare a delete action IAW appendix E-201 P, and hold the reentry action until the deletion action(s) have processed.

d. VRC I6.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

VRC I6 indicates that pos. 66-69 of the input card contains an entry other than a valid FSC recorded on the DSC FSC table or alpha indicators NNNN or XXXX. Alpha NNNN indicates that the activity involved is permitted to requisition Part Numbers/Non-NSN items from DLA; alpha XXXX indicates that the activity is permitted to requisition any/all FSCs managed by a DSC.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

(a) When it is determined that the FSC is valid and specific item(s) for this FSC are managed by the DSC, a review will be conducted of the FSC table, appendix F-206. When the FSC is not recorded in the F-206, a ZLS card will be input IAW appendix B-200 for the specific FSC and with the DSCs RIC after this action has posted to the FSC table the violation DIC ZLG will be reentered IAW paragraph 5 below.

(b) Review violation output against the Cross-Service Agreement to determine correct FSC and/or alpha indicator which is being added, changed, or deleted from FEDSTRIP - FSC Support Table (appendix F-142), and reinput IAW paragraph 5 below.

e. VRC PU.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

VRC PU indicates the FEDSTRIP Activity Address Code (AAC) in pos. 8-13 and/or the FSC in pos. 66-69 of the input document is other than that which appears on the FEDSTRIP - FSC Support Table. Therefore, delete action indicated by Action Code AB in pos. 79-80 of the input document could not be accomplished.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Review the violation against the delete notification that prompted the deletion attempt and the applicable Agency/Activity Agreement to determine the correct FEDSTRIP Activity/Agency or FSC to be deleted. Correct and forward for reinput IAW paragraph 5.

f. VRC V7.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

VRC V7 indicates the Service/Agency Code in pos. 8-9 is invalid or blank, or the specific FEDSTRIP AAC in pos. 8-13 is blank or invalid. Service/Agency Codes for FEDSTRIP activities must be numeric, as reflected in appendix A-20.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Upon receipt of the violation document, determine the correct FEDSTRIP Activity Code/Address by reference to the formal Cross-Service Agreement being processed and appendix A-20 or determine that the designator XX indicating that the agreement applies to all FEDSTRIP activities.

5. REENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

a. Review remaining data elements contained in Violation Output Document to detect any other invalid data, and correct as necessary.

b. Reentry method for violations is contingent upon type of Violation Output Document which is a local option and recorded in the ORC Table (appendix F-20). The following codes are the various options with reentry instructions:

1	ZLR - Controlled Violation Listing, appendix F-122	Using either Violation Listing, appendix F-122, or Violation/Suspense Control Reentry Card, appendix B-66, enter corrected data and/or Violation Reentry Code (appendix A-62) with colored pencil or ink and submit as prescribed in appendix E-066 P.
3	Uncontrolled Violation, appendix F-117	Reentry, when required, is accomplished as prescribed in appendix E-346 P.
