3. PURPOSE, CONTENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This appendix provides instructions for the research, correction and deletion of current LR Transaction violations. Violation reasons are listed below, in alphabetic order. The LR Monitor, DSO, is responsible for processing the violations.

O7	NIIN invalid (NIIN nonnumeric or NATO Code pos. 8 and 9 invalid).
PB	Card Identification Code (CIC) invalid.
PF	Output Routing Code (ORC) invalid (must = 093).
QF	Federal Supply Class (FSC) not assigned to this DSC.
****YLR ON SUSPENSE FILE 15 DAYS OLD - ADDED YYDDD (JULIAN DATE) ****	YLR has been on Suspense File more than 15 days.
****YLR ON SUSPENSE FILE 30 DAYS OLD - ADDED YYDDD (JULIAN DATE) ****	YLR has been on Suspense File more than 30 days.

4. PROCESSING/RESEARCH INSTRUCTIONS

a. VRC AY.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates NSN, entered in pos. 4-16 (CIC K) is blank, unmatched or duplicated.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Verify NSN, correct and reinput as necessary.

b. VRC CF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates that the Action Code is invalid (not equal to D, R, or space).

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Correct Action Code and reinput YLR.

c. VRC I6.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates FSC is invalid (not recorded in Table 80).

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Verify FSC, in pos. 4-7 or 23-26 and validate Table 80 F-378 Report as appropriate, correct and reinput as necessary.

d. VRC JO.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates Originating, Submitting or Gaining Manager Activity Code is invalid.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Verify Catalog Activity Code (see appendix A-137), correct and reinput as necessary.

e. VRC 07.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates NIIN, entered in pos. 8-16 (CIC K) is invalid, or NATO Code in pos. 8-9 is invalid.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Verify NATO Code and/or NIIN (see National Codification Bureau Code, appendix A-164) correct and reinput as necessary.

f. VRC PB.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates Card Identification Code, entered in pos. 22 (CIC) is invalid.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Verify CIC must equal K for specific NSN transfer, or L for class transfer, or L for residual NSN from class transfer. Correct and reinput as necessary.

g. VRC PF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates Output Routing Code, entered in pos. 17-19 is invalid.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Verify ORC (must equal 093, LR Monitor), correct and reinput as necessary.

h. VRC QF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates FSC, entered in pos. 4-7 (CIC K or L) is not assigned to the originating DSC.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Check FSC on Table 80, (DLAM 4130.3, Volume II, Part 10, Appendix E-1019 P), correct and reinput as necessary.

i. VRC: \*\*\*\*YLR ON SUSPENSE FILE 15 DAYS OLD - ADDED YYDDD\*\*\*\*.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates a YLR has been on the Suspense File for over 15 days without delete or release action.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Reenter with correct Action Code, i.e., D, delete or R, release.

j. VRC: \*\*\*\*YLR ON SUSPENSE FILE 30 DAYS OLD - ADDED YYDDD\*\*\*\*.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates a YLR has been on the Suspense File for over 30 days without delete or release action.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Reenter with correct Action Code, i.e., D, delete or R, release.

k. VRC: DELETE YLR UNMATCHED TO SUSPENSE.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates YLR does not match the Suspense File on either FSC or GIM.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Verify GIM and FSC, correct and reinput as necessary.

l. VRC: DELETED FROM SUSPENSE FILE.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

YLR with Action Code D matched Suspense File and has been deleted.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

No further action is required.

m. VRC: NO LVAs GENERATED THIS CYCLE.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

This message is output to indicate that no new LVAs were sent to DLSC, intended to preclude concern about missing F-26A Reports.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

None required.

n. VRC: NSN UNMATCHED TO SUPPLY MANAGEMENT STATUS FILE.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates that the SMSF contained no matching NSNs in the entire FSC (formerly output as VRC WF on F-441).

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Obtain current Total Item Record (TIR) from DLSC; if NSN is active, establish SMSF. Check applicable YLR, correct and reenter if necessary.

o. VRC: RELEASED YLR UNMATCHED TO SUSPENSE FILE ON CLASS.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates that a YLR with Action Code D or R was received but does not have a matching YLR on the Suspense File.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Verify FSC on YLR, correct and reinput as necessary.

p. VRC: RELEASED FROM THE SUSPENSE FILE.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Notification that YLR with Action Code equal to R has been released from the Suspense File.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

No further action is required.

q. VRC: SMSF STATUS CODE NOT N, B OR G SMS = ( \_ )

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates that this NSN did not reflect an active Status Code (B, G or N), current SMS Code is displayed in the VRC/Message.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

If this YLR was received from DLSC, it is an indication that DLSC had coded this item as active. Obtain current Total Item Record (TIR) from DLSC; if NSN is active, establish SMSF. Check applicable YLR, correct and reenter if necessary.

r. VRC: YLR ADDED TO THE SUSPENSE FILE.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Notification that YLR with Action Code equal to SPACE has been added to the Suspense File.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Verify that action is required and reinput with Action Code R to release, or D to delete as required.

s. VRC: YLR GIM UNMATCHED TO SUSPENSE FILE GIM.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates YLR does not match the Suspense File on GIM.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Verify GIM and FSC, correct and reinput as necessary.

t. VRC: YLR RECEIVED PRESENT IN SUSPENSE FILE.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates that matching YLR is present on Suspense File.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Check applicable YLR, correct and reenter if necessary.

u. VRC: YLR UNMATCHED TO SUPPLY MANAGEMENT STATUS FILE.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation indicates that the SMSF contained no matching NSN (formerly output as VRC WF on F-441).

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Obtain current Total Item Record (TIR from DLSC; if NSN is active, establish SMSF. Check applicable YLR, correct and reenter as necessary.

5. REENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

a. Review remaining data elements on output document to detect any other invalid data, and correct as necessary.

b. Reentry method for violations is via Four-Phase data entry system.
