RESIDUAL ASSET DECAPITALIZATION ACTIVATOR DOCUMENT VIOLATIONS

1. INPUT DOCUMENT

Residual Asset Decapitalization Activator Document, DIC ZLW, appendix B-238.

2. PURPOSE, CONTENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This appendix provides instructions for the research, correction, and reentry of Residual Asset Decapitalization Activator Documents which have been rejected from computer processing. Violation Reason Codes are listed below in alphabetical order. The Materiel Support Branch within the Directorate of Supply Operations is responsible for processing all violations described herein.

AB	Invalid Routing Identifier Code.
AF	Invalid Condition Code.
AI	Document Number Invalid or Blank.
AN	Unit of Issue Invalid or Blank.

EN	National Stock Number Unmatched.
FP	Unmatched Logistics Reassignment Loss File.
SL	Quantity not available in NIR.
TF	Invalid or Blank Effective Transfer Date.

3. PROCESSING/RESEARCH INSTRUCTIONS

a. VRC AB.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation Reason Code AB indicates that the GIM in the DIC ZLW differs from the GIM in the LR Loss File (LRLF).

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Compare handscribed copy of input document and the Logistics Reassignment (LR) Loss File and review for errors. Reinput with correct GIM RIC.

b. VRC AF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation Reason Code AF indicates that the input document contains an invalid condition code in pos. 71.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Processing personnel will review handscribed input document and/or appendix F-28, Logistics Reassignment On-Hand Assets not Decapped. The acceptable condition codes for decapitalization are available for viewing on the LRLF (see DLAH 4745.2, Volume I, DLA Remote Users Handbook for assistance).

c. VRC AI.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation Reason Code AI indicates that the input document contains an invalid document number field, pos. 30-43.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Processing personnel will review copy of handscribed input document and/or document number control register for the correct document number. Reenter the corrected document number.

d. VRC AN.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation Reason Code AN indicates that the unit of issue in pos. 23-24 of input document does not match the unit of issue in the NIR.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Compare input of handscribed document UI to NIR UI and correct error.

e. VRC AR.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation Reason Code AR indicates that the input document contains a blank or invalid purpose code in pos. 70.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Review handscribed copy of input document and/or appendix F-28, Report of On-Hand Assets. The acceptable purpose codes for decapitalization are listed in the LRLF (see DLAH 4745.2 for assistance). Reenter transaction with acceptable codes.

f. VRC AS.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation Reason Code AS indicates that the input document contains an invalid or zero quantity in pos. 25-29, i.e., digits are blank or other than numerics.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Processing personnel will review copy of handscribed input document and/or source document (appendix F-28) in order to ascertain the correct quantity. Reenter with corrected quantity.

g. VRC AW.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation Reason Code AW indicates that the management code field, pos. 72, contains other than a blank.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Processing personnel will review the decapitalization action in progress and obtain a duplicate copy of the coding document and ensure that pos. 72 was blank.

h. VRC EN.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation Reason Code EN indicates that the NSN in pos. 8-20 of input document does not match an NSN in the NIR.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Compare input document NSN to NIR NSN and RIC on the source document. If different, convert the input document to the source document NSN. If same, delete the violation.

h. VRC FP.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation Reason Code FP indicates that the input document contains an NSN in pos. 8-20 that is not recorded in the Logistics Reassignment Loss File (LRLF).

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

Access the National Inventory Record File (NIRF) by using the SAMMSTEL Verb SNIR, or DIC ZCQ (appendix B-143) to ascertain the NIR Key Code of DX or DZ. If one of the two Key Codes is not present, contact the LR monitor in the LPD to see if the NSN was a LOG LOSS item.

i. VRC SL.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation Reason Code SL indicates that the DIC ZLW quantity is greater than the quantity available for transfer in the NIR. The amount which exceeds the NIR O/H quantity is output for violation.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

This violation indicates that quantity above the NIR quantity has violated, compare quantities from the DIC ZLW and NIR and correct.

j. VRC TF.

(1) REASON FOR VIOLATION/ERROR CONDITION

Violation Reason Code TF indicates that pos. 62-64 contains data other than numerics 001-366 or is blank and is therefore considered an invalid effective transfer date.

(2) PROCESSING/RESEARCH REQUIRED

This violation indicates that the ETD is incorrect. Review a copy of input document (DIC ZLW) and/or source document (appendix F-28) which prompted the input, in order to ascertain the correct Effective Transfer Date.

4. REENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

a. Review remaining data elements contained in violation output to detect any other invalid data and correct as necessary.

b. Reentry methods for violation are contingent upon type of violation. Type of output is an option recorded in the Output Routing Code Table (appendix F-20).

c. Violation corrections may be reinput using the SAMMETEL Verb SVRR.
