PORT OF EMBARKATION (POE)/FEDERAL SUPPLY CLASS (FSC) TO NEAREST
DEFENSE DEPOT ACTIVITY ADDRESS CODE (DoDAAC) CROSS-REFERENCE TABLE CARD

1. INPUT DOCUMENT

Port of Embarkation/FSC to nearest Defense Depot AAC Cross-Reference Table Card, appendix B-242, DIC ZLN.

2. PURPOSE

This card will be used to add, change or delete data and be used to request a printout of the table. See appendix F-258.

3. RESPONSIBLE ORGANIZATIONAL ELEMENT

Additions, deletions, and changes to the POE/FSC to nearest Defense Depot AAC Cross-Reference Table are the responsibility of the Materiel Support Branch, MSO, DSO.

4. PROCEDURES/INSTRUCTIONS

The Materiel Support Branch will:

a. Initially load the table by preparing appendix B-242.

(1) From DoDR 4500.32R, MILSTAMP, appendix B, section IV, Water Port Identifier Codes (WPIC), select the first two positions of each WPIC beginning with 1, 2, 3, 4. Each abbreviated WPIC will be cross-referenced with FSCs and respective depot DoD AACs. This load is for part I.

(2) For part II, use the same manual and select the Air Terminal Identifier Codes (ATIC) (the complete three digit code). Select only CONUS ATICs.

b. Then based on the distribution pattern, select the storage location closest to the POE and determine those FSCs managed which are stored at that location. In order to hold down the size of the table, multiple FSCs stored at the same location will be reflected as all 9s in the input card with the AAC of the storage locations. FSCs not stored at that location will be entered individually with the respective storage locations. For example, if a DSC manages 25 FSCs and the depot selected closest to the POE stores 20 of those classes, it will be necessary to:

(1) Prepare 1 input (B-242) with POE, FSC (all 9s) and the depot AAC (for the 20 classes).

(2) Prepare 5 different inputs (B-242) with same POE, different FSCs and different depot AACs for the remaining classes.

NOTE: Use of the term POE means the same as WPIC and ATIC; the terms POE and WPIC and POE and ATIC can be used interchangeably.

c. After table is loaded initially, submit an input with Action Code AC to obtain a printout of the file. Only DIC, RIC, and Action Code are required.

d. Update the table when a new FSC is assigned if the storage activity closest to the POE does not stock FSC. In this case the FSC and storage location will be added (Action Code AA) for the POE.

e. Review changes to appendix B of DoD 4500.32R to determine if new POEs have been assigned. New POEs will be established IAW the initial load instructions. Deletion of POEs will be prepared by input of appendix B-242. Only DIC, RIC, and Action Code AB are required.

5. PROCEDURES FOR PROCESSING REPORT

Report will be reviewed to assure that the POE/FSC to nearest Defense Depot AAC Cross-Reference Table Card is up to date and valid.

6. DISPOSITION OF REPORT AFTER REVIEW

The report will be destroyed upon replacement by a later dated report.
